

# GET TO KNOW YOUR NEW CATHEDRAL

Have you taken a guided tour of the Cathedral yet? Visitors (dozens per week) take these tours but many of our regular parishioners have not yet taken one. We would like to invite you to consider taking a tour of this newly restored building with one of our trained guides. Tours are scheduled every Sunday following the 11:00 am Mass and every Wednesday following the 12:10 pm Mass. Tours can also be arranged for special groups at other times of the week. The tours last about 45 minutes and cover the history of the building and the story behind the 2005 restoration, covering a variety of features: the dome (which was reopened after 70 years), the new Baptism font, the

murals in the side chapels, the Eucharistic Chapel, the sanctuary lamp that was missing from the cathedral until a lady (who had it hanging in her home) sold it back to the Diocese of Sacramento.

Books available in the gift shop include a 32-page self-guided tour of the Cathedral with colorful photos of the interior and concise commentary on the most important features of the building. That book is available for \$5. Also available in the gift shop is the coffee table book (English and Spanish

versions available) on the restoration for \$20 per copy. Both books are ideal souvenirs and ideal gifts for Christmas.
