Significant numbers of people have been signing up to become Cathedral parish members since we reopened in November. New registrations are now averaging over 50 per month—about half using the bulletin and half using the Web site.

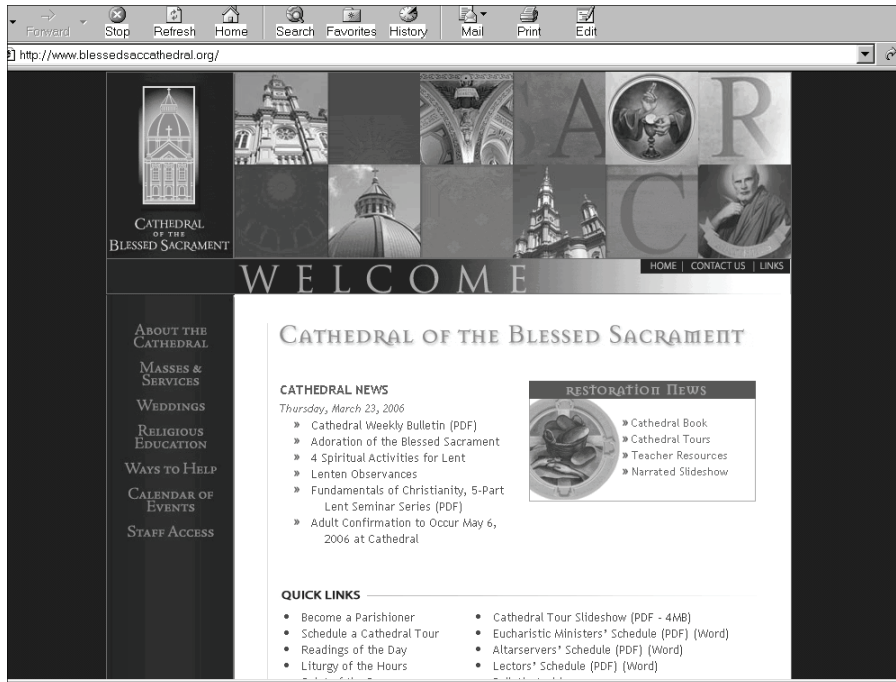
If you come to church at the Cathedral but have not yet registered we invite you to consider doing so. All you have to do is fill out the registration form at the bottom of the right hand page in the bulletin and drop it in the collection basket.
