## A LETTER FROM THE BISHOP

Dear Parishioners:

As you may have already learned, the Diocese received an allegation of sexual misconduct against Fr. Rodolfo Delgado for an incident alleged to have taken place in 1983. In accordance with our policies, Father Delgado has been placed on administrative leave and an investigation is being conducted. While on administrative leave, Father Delgado may not engage in priestly ministry. We do not assume that Father Delgado is guilty, but we take the allegation very seriously.

As part of the investigation of this allegation, I am asking for assistance from each parish where Father Delgado has served. He served in your parish from December 19, 1982, to November 30, 1987. We have no reason to suspect that other complaints might surface. Nonetheless, if you have any information about other possible incidents or know of other persons who could provide information, please call the **Diocese toll-free at (866) 777-9133** and leave a message. Someone from the Diocese will follow up with you as soon as possible.
