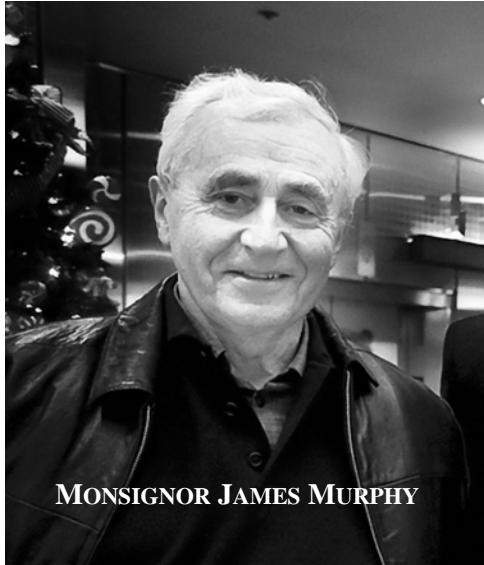


# GET YOUR TICKETS TODAY FOR GALA
