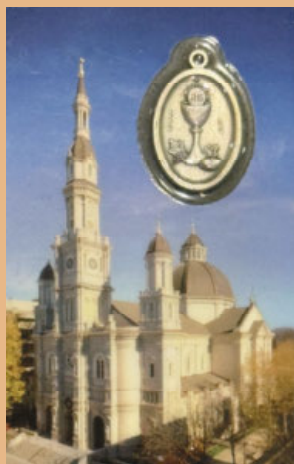

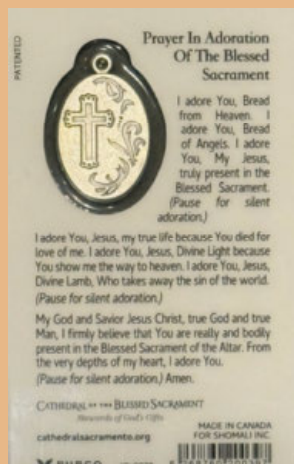

Recently, the Cathedral Tours Docent Ministry and guests celebrated the Cathedral's "birthday" (i.e., consecration, June 1889) at our annual potluck and Continuing Education presentation. We enriched our knowledge about the Cathedral's history with guest speaker, Monsignor James Murphy, who presented the lead up to the 2003-05 restoration and the few years following. Afterwards was a lively Q&A and we considered ourselves very blessed to have heard from such a prominent speaker and author on all things related to the significant restoration. Following the presentation was a bountiful potluck with dishes representing our diverse parish from Latin America, Asia, Africa, Spain, and other points on the map.

Social Teaching of the Church The Call to Family, Community and Participation

"It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a helper suited to him."
Genesis 2:18

Pilgrims of Hope: Called to family, community and participation.

Two weeks ago we began to reflect on Catholic Social Teaching. Last week we considered the first one, on Life and Dignity of the Human Person. This week we are going to consider the 'Call to Family, Community and Participation' in society. The person is not only sacred but also social. Marriage and the family are the central social institutions that must be supported and strengthened. In his encyclical *Fratelli Tutti*, Pope Francis said: "The existence of each individual is deeply tied to that of others: life is not simply time that passes; life is a time for interactions." #66. It can be understood that Human beings, then, are so made that they cannot live, develop and find fulfillment except 'in the sincere gift of self to others.' The family is the nucleus by which we learn how to interact with the world. We learn governance, order, and collaboration. It is in this companionship that human beings.

Gaudium et Spes teaches:

"God did not create man as a solitary for from the beginning 'male and female he created them' (Gen 1:27). Companionship produces the primary form of interpersonal communion. For by his inmost nature man is a social being, (without it) he can neither live nor develop his potential." #12.

Hace dos semanas comenzamos a reflexionar sobre la Doctrina Social de la Iglesia. La semana pasada consideramos la primera, sobre la Vida y la Dignidad de la Persona Humana. Esta semana vamos a considerar la «Llamada a la familia, la comunidad y la participación» en la sociedad.

La persona no es sólo sagrada, sino también social. El matrimonio y la familia son las instituciones sociales centrales que deben ser apoyadas y fortalecidas. En su encíclica *Fratelli Tutti*, el Papa Francisco dijo: «La existencia de cada individuo está profundamente ligada a la de los demás: la vida no es simplemente tiempo que pasa; la vida es tiempo de interacciones» #66. Se puede entender, pues, que el ser humano está hecho de tal manera que no puede vivir, desarrollarse y realizarse sino «en el don sincero de sí mismo a los demás». La familia es el núcleo mediante el cual aprendemos a interactuar con el mundo. Aprendemos gobierno, orden y colaboración. Es en esta compañía donde los seres humanos.

Gaudium et Spes enseña:

"Dios no creó al hombre en solitario, pues desde el principio 'varón y hembra los creó' (Gn 1, 27). Su compañía produce la primera forma de comunión interpersonal. Porque por su naturaleza íntima el hombre es un ser social, (sin ella) no puede vivir ni desarrollar sus potencialidades." #12.

Genesis 18:20-32
Psalms 138:1-2, 2-3, 6-7, 7-8
Colossians 2:12-14
Luke 11:1-13

Summary of the Readings:

First Reading – God tells Abraham He will check on Sodom and Gomorrah's sin. Abraham asks God to spare the city if ten innocent people are found, and God agrees.

Responsorial Psalm – I thank the Lord for hearing my prayers, giving me strength, and protecting me. His kindness lasts forever, and He will complete His work for me.

Second Reading – In baptism, you were buried and raised with Christ. God forgave your sins, canceled your debt, and made you alive with Christ.

Gospel – Jesus teaches His disciples how to pray and emphasizes persistence in prayer, assuring them that God will answer. He highlights God's readiness to give the Holy Spirit to those who ask.

Our readings next Sunday focus on prayer and trusting in God. We see in Abraham what it means to intercede for others as he asks for the life of the innocent in the towns not to be destroyed. In the Gospel, Jesus tells a parable of the importance of persistence in our prayer, saying that God listens when we ask, seek and knock. Ask the Lord to make your faith stronger as you place everything in His loving hands.

Reflect:

- ♦ How can I make my prayers more open and honest with God?
- ♦ What does calling God "Father" mean to me in my prayer life?
- ♦ What can I learn from Abraham's boldness in asking God for mercy?
- ♦ What steps can I take to deepen my trust in God through prayer?

Resumen de las lecturas:

Primera lectura - Dios dice a Abraham que comprobará el pecado de Sodoma y Gomorra. Abraham pide a Dios que perdone la ciudad si se encuentran diez inocentes, y Dios accede.

Salmo responsorial - Doy gracias al Señor por escuchar mis oraciones, darme fuerzas y protegerme. Su bondad es eterna y Él completará su obra en mi favor.

Segunda lectura - En el bautismo, fuisteis sepultados y resucitasteis con Cristo. Dios perdonó tus pecados, canceló tu deuda y te dio vida con Cristo.

Evangelio - Jesús enseña a sus discípulos cómo orar y hace hincapié en la persistencia en la oración, asegurándoles que Dios responderá. Destaca que Dios está dispuesto a dar el Espíritu Santo a quienes se lo pidan.

Nuestras lecturas del próximo domingo se centran en la oración y en la confianza en Dios. Vemos en Abraham lo que significa interceder por los demás cuando pide que se destruya la vida de los inocentes de las ciudades. En el Evangelio, Jesús cuenta una parábola sobre la importancia de la persistencia en nuestra oración, diciendo que Dios escucha cuando pedimos, busquemos y llamamos. Pide al Señor que fortalezca tu fe mientras pones todo en sus manos amorosas.

Reflexar:

- ♦ ¿Cómo puedo hacer que mis oraciones sean más abiertas y sinceras con Dios?
- ♦ ¿Qué significa para mí llamar a Dios «Padre» en mi vida de oración?
- ♦ ¿Qué puedo aprender de la valentía de Abraham al pedir misericordia a Dios?
- ♦ ¿Qué pasos puedo dar para profundizar mi confianza en Dios a través de la oración?

Liturgy of the Word

SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Reading 1 **Gn 18:1-10a**

The LORD appeared to Abraham by the terebinth of Mamre, as he sat in the entrance of his tent, while the day was growing hot. Looking up, Abraham saw three men standing nearby. When he saw them, he ran from the entrance of the tent to greet them; and bowing to the ground, he said: "Sir, if I may ask you this favor, please do not go on past your servant. Let some water be brought, that you may bathe your feet, and then rest yourselves under the tree. Now that you have come this close to your servant, let me bring you a little food, that you may refresh yourselves; and afterward you may go on your way." The men replied, "Very well, do as you have said."

Abraham hastened into the tent and told Sarah, "Quick, three measures of fine flour! Knead it and make rolls." He ran to the herd, picked out a tender, choice steer, and gave it to a servant, who quickly prepared it. Then Abraham got some curds and milk, as well as the steer that had been prepared, and set these before the three men; and he waited on them under the tree while they ate.

They asked Abraham, "Where is your wife Sarah?" He replied, "There in the tent." One of them said, "I will surely return to you about this time next year, and Sarah will then have a son."

Primera lectura

Gen 18, 1-10a

Un día, el Señor se le apareció a Abraham en el encinar de Mambré. Abraham estaba sentado en la entrada de su tienda, a la hora del calor más fuerte. Levantando la vista, vio de pronto a tres hombres que estaban de pie ante él. 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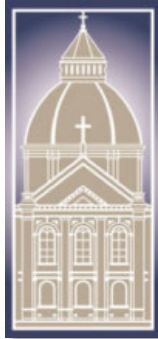

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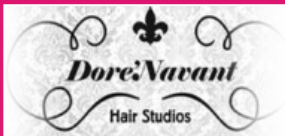
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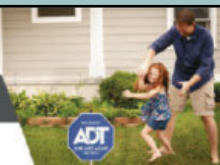
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
