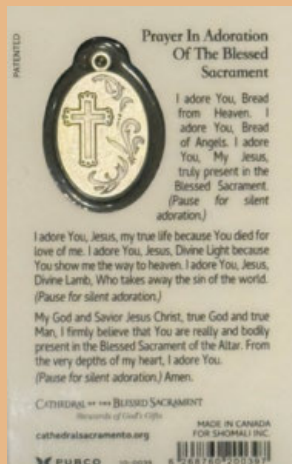

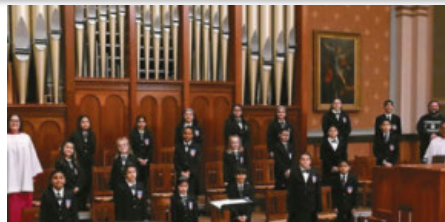

Summary of the Readings:

- **First Reading** – Isaiah 66:18-21: The Lord gathers people from all nations to see his glory and spread it. They will bring offerings and some will become priests and Levites.
- **Responsorial Psalm** – Psalms 117: Praise the Lord, all nations. His kindness is steadfast, and his faithfulness lasts forever.
- **Second Reading** – Hebrews 12:5-7, 11-13: God disciplines those he loves, just as a father disciplines his children. Endure trials as discipline; they will later bring righteousness and healing.
- **Gospel** – Luke 13:22-30: Jesus teaches that many will try to enter through the narrow gate but fail. He warns that some who are last will be first, and some who are first will be last.

Next Sunday's readings teach us that following God takes effort. The path is not always easy. We must make real choices and not wait too long. We do not know how much time we have before we either die or that God's kingdom comes. God wants us to stay strong, even when life is hard, so we can be prepared / ready when we meet Him when He comes again.

Reflect:

- ♦ When Jesus speaks of entering through the narrow gate, he challenges us to go through the narrow way (the Gospel); we often choose instead what is comfortable and easy. What are the 'easy' things in your life you need to change?
- ♦ The second reading speaks of the need for discipline in the spiritual life. What is one thing you can add to your spiritual discipline that will help you stay close to Jesus? Is there something in your life that is not helpful?
- ♦ Pray with Psalm 117.

Resumen de las lecturas:

- **Primera lectura** - Isaías 66,18-21: El Señor reúne a gentes de todas las naciones para que vean su gloria y la difundan. Traerán ofrendas y algunos se convertirán en sacerdotes y levitas.
- **Salmo responsorial** - Salmo 117: Alabad al Señor, naciones todas. Su bondad es inquebrantable y su fidelidad eterna.
- **Segunda lectura** - Hebreos 12,5-7.11-13: Dios disciplina a los que ama, como un padre disciplina a sus hijos. Soportad las pruebas como disciplina; más tarde traerán justicia y curación.
- **Evangelio** - Lucas 13,22-30: Jesús enseña que muchos intentarán entrar por la puerta estrecha, pero fracasarán. Advierte que algunos de los últimos serán los primeros, y algunos de los primeros serán los últimos.

Las lecturas de este domingo nos enseñan que seguir a Dios requiere esfuerzo. El camino no siempre es fácil. Debemos tomar decisiones reales y no esperar demasiado. No sabemos cuánto tiempo nos queda antes de morir o de que llegue el reino de Dios; Dios quiere que nos mantengamos fuertes, incluso cuando la vida es dura, para estar preparados / listos cuando nos encontremos con Él cuando venga de nuevo.

Reflejar:

- ♦ Cuando Jesús habla de entrar por la puerta estrecha, nos desafía a recorrer el camino estrecho (el Evangelio); a menudo elegimos lo que es cómodo y fácil. ¿Cuáles son las cosas «fáciles» en tu vida que necesitas cambiar?
- ♦ La segunda lectura habla de la necesidad de disciplina en la vida espiritual. ¿Qué puedes añadir a tu disciplina espiritual que te ayude a permanecer cerca de Jesús? ¿Hay algo en tu vida que no te ayude?
- ♦ Reza con el Salmo 117

Liturgy of the Word

TWENTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

READING 1 JER 38:4-6, 8-10

In those days, the princes said to the king:

"Jeremiah ought to be put to death; he is demoralizing the soldiers who are left in this city, and all the people, by speaking such things to them; he is not interested in the welfare of our people, but in their ruin." King Zedekiah answered: "He is in your power"; for the king could do nothing with them. And so they took Jeremiah and threw him into the cistern of Prince Malchiah, which was in the quarters of the guard, letting him down with ropes. There was no water in the cistern, only mud, and Jeremiah sank into the mud.

Ebed-melech, a court official, went there from the palace and said to him: "My lord king, these men have been at fault in all they have done to the prophet Jeremiah, casting him into the cistern. He will die of famine on the spot, for there is no more food in the city." Then the king ordered Ebed-melech the Cushite to take three men along with him, and draw the prophet Jeremiah out of the cistern before he should die.

XX DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO 17 DE AGOSTO DE 2025

PRIMERA LECTURA JER 38, 4-6. 8-10

Durante el sitio de Jerusalén, los jefes que tenían prisionero a Jeremías dijeron al rey: "Hay que matar a este hombre, porque las cosas que dice desmoralizan a los guerreros que quedan en esta ciudad y a todo el pueblo. Es evidente que no busca el bienestar del pueblo, sino su perdición"

Respondió el rey Sedecías: "Lo tienen ya en sus manos y el rey no puede nada contra ustedes". Entonces ellos tomaron a Jeremías y, descolgándolo con cuerdas, lo echaron en el pozo del príncipe Melquías, situado en el patio de la prisión. En el pozo no había agua, sino lodo, y Jeremías quedó hundido en el lodo.
