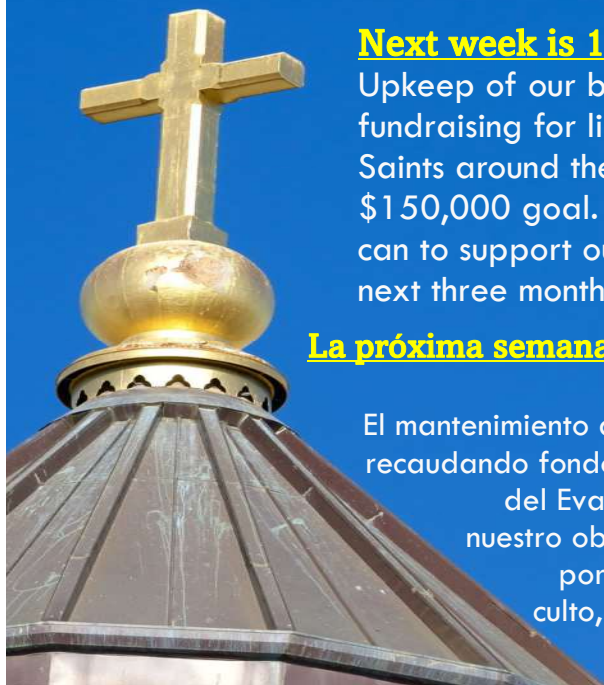

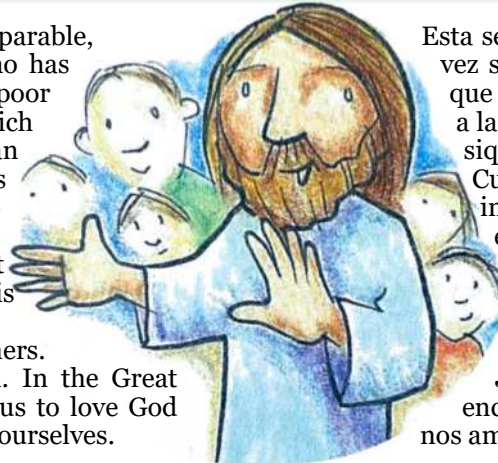

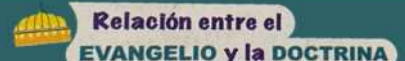
This week, Jesus tells another parable, this time about a rich man who has everything he wants, and a poor man who is right outside the rich man's door, but the rich man doesn't even give him scraps from his table. When the two men die, their fortune reverses and the poor man finds comfort in heaven while the rich man is thirsty and suffering in hell. Jesus teaches us to notice others. He wants us to care for them. In the Great Commandment, Jesus teaches us to love God first, and love others as we love ourselves.



Esta semana, Jesús cuenta otra parábola, esta vez sobre un hombre rico que tiene todo lo que desea y un hombre pobre que está justo a las puertas de la casa del rico, pero este ni siquiera le da las sobras de su mesa. 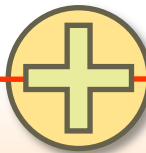

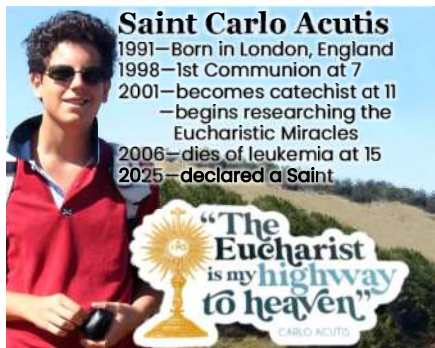

Summary of the Readings:

- **First Reading** – Habakkuk 1:2-3; 2:2-4: Despite witnessing violence and injustice, the plea for divine intervention is met with God's instruction to record a future vision that promises fulfillment and vindicates the just who live by faith.
- **Responsorial Psalm** – Psalm 95: We are called to worship joyfully, remember God as our creator and shepherd, and keep our hearts open, recalling the lessons from Meribah and Massah.
- **Second Reading** – 2 Timothy 1:6-8, 13-14: Reignite the divine gift within you, embracing God's spirit of power, love, and discipline, and steadfastly proclaim your faith, guided and protected by the Holy Spirit.
- **Gospel** – Luke 17:5-10: Jesus teaches that even a small amount of faith can achieve great things and compares this to a servant's duty, emphasizing that fulfilling obligations is simply doing what is expected.

Reflect:

Jesus said: "If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you." Jeff Cavins explains that when we apply our faith in the small things (the mustard seed) our faith grows to have faith in the impossible events that need God's help.

- ♦ When have you struggled with doubt or impatience in your faith? How can you trust in God's timing, even when answers seem delayed?
- ♦ What are the small things you are called to put in God's hands? How can you see that these can lead to greater courage and trust in God?
- ♦ In what ways can you live out your faith in daily life?
- ♦ Pray with Psalm 95.

Resumen de las lecturas:

- **Primera lectura** – Habacuc 1:2-3; 2:2-4: A pesar de ser testigo de la violencia y la injusticia, la súplica de intervención divina es respondida con la instrucción de Dios de registrar una visión futura que promete la realización y vindica a los justos que viven por la fe.
- **Salmo responsorial** – Salmo 95: Estamos llamados a adorar con alegría, a recordar a Dios como nuestro creador y pastor, y a mantener nuestros corazones abiertos, recordando las lecciones de Meribá y Masá.
- **Segunda lectura** – 2 Timoteo 1:6-8, 13-14: Reaviva el don divino que hay en ti, abrazando el espíritu de poder, amor y disciplina de Dios, y proclama con firmeza tu fe, guiado y protegido por el Espíritu Santo.
- **Evangelio** – Lucas 17:5-10: Jesús enseña que incluso una pequeña cantidad de fe puede lograr grandes cosas y compara esto con el deber de un siervo, enfatizando que cumplir con las obligaciones es simplemente hacer lo que se espera.

Reflejar:

Jesús dijo: «Si tuvieran fe, aunque fuera tan pequeña como una semilla de mostaza, podrían decir a ese árbol frondoso: 'Arráncate de raíz y plántate en el mar', y los obedecería». Jeff Cavins explica que cuando aplicamos nuestra fe en las cosas pequeñas (el grano de mostaza), nuestra fe crece hasta tener fe en los acontecimientos imposibles que necesitan la ayuda de Dios.

- ♦ ¿Cuándo has luchado con la duda o la impaciencia en tu fe? ¿Cómo puedes confiar en el tiempo de Dios, incluso cuando las respuestas parecen tardar en llegar?
- ♦ ¿Cuáles son las pequeñas cosas que estás llamado a poner en manos de Dios? ¿Cómo puedes ver que estas pueden llevarte a un mayor valor y confianza en Dios?
- ♦ ¿De qué maneras puedes vivir tu fe en la vida cotidiana?
- ♦ Reza con el Salmo 95.

Jesus said to the Pharisees:

"There was a rich man who dressed in purple garments and fine linen and dined sumptuously each day. And lying at his door was a poor man named Lazarus, covered with sores, who would gladly have eaten his fill of the scraps that fell from the rich man's table. Dogs even used to come and lick his sores.

When the poor man died, he was carried away by angels to the bosom of Abraham. The rich man also died and was buried, and from the netherworld, where he was in torment, he raised his eyes and saw Abraham far off and Lazarus at his side. And he cried out, 'Father Abraham, have pity on me.

Send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, for I am suffering torment in these flames.' Abraham replied, 'My child, remember that you received what was good during your lifetime while Lazarus likewise received what was bad; but now he is comforted here, whereas you are tormented. Moreover, between us and you a great chasm is established to prevent anyone from crossing who might wish to go from our side to yours or from your side to ours.' He said, 'Then I beg you, father, send him to my father's house, for I have five brothers, so that he may warn them, lest they too come to this place of torment.' But Abraham replied, 'They have Moses and the prophets. Let them listen to them.' He said, 'Oh no, father Abraham, but if someone from the dead goes to them, they will repent.' Then Abraham said, 'If they will not listen to Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded if someone should rise from the dead.'"

Abraham repuso: 'Si no escuchan a Moisés y a los profetas, no harán caso, ni aunque resucite un muerto'".

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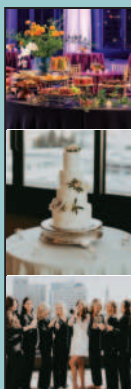
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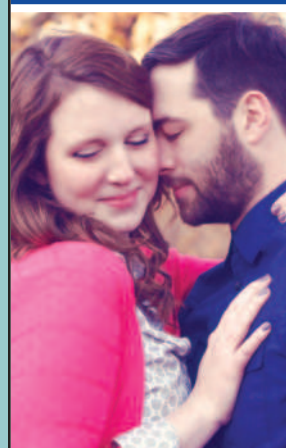
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
