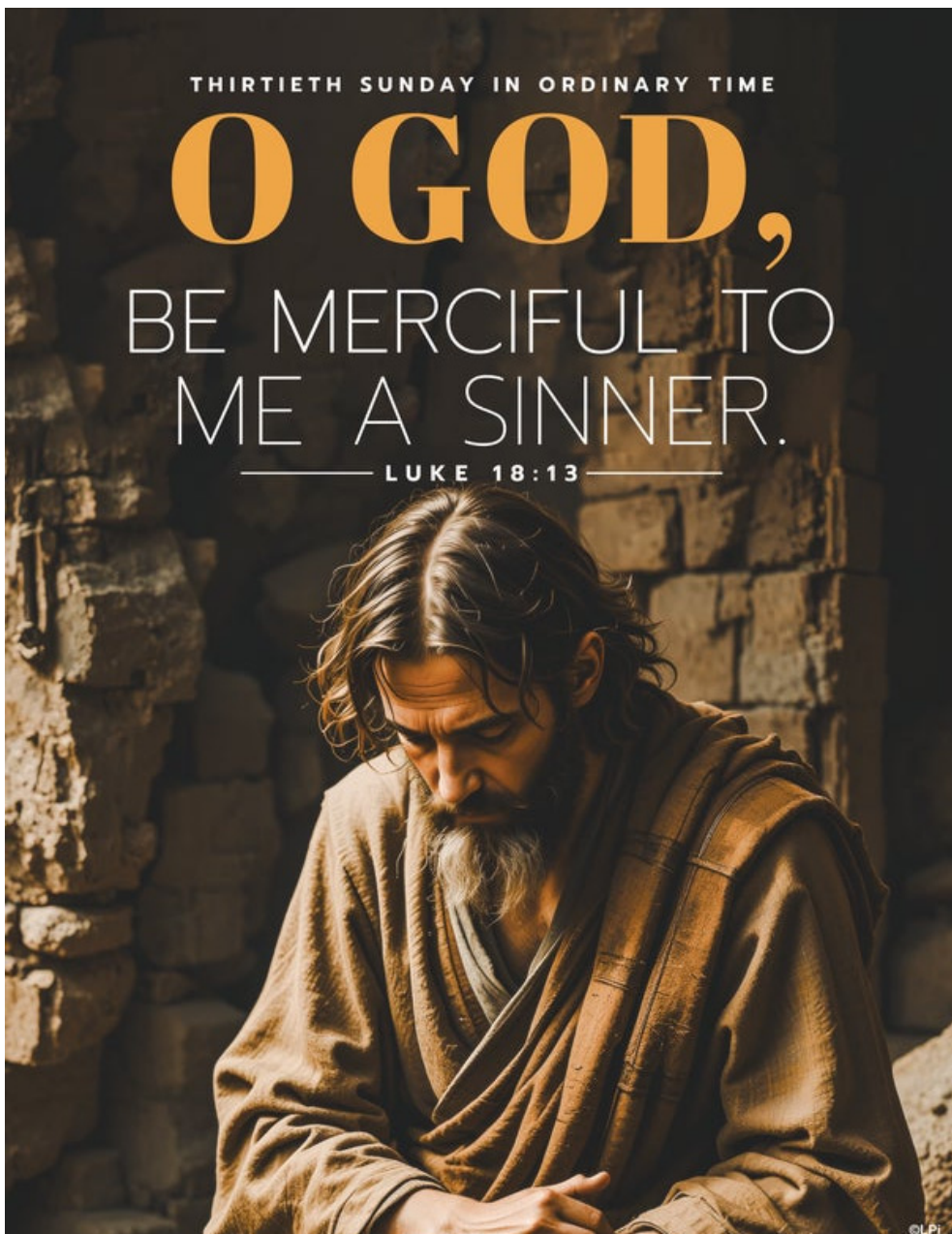

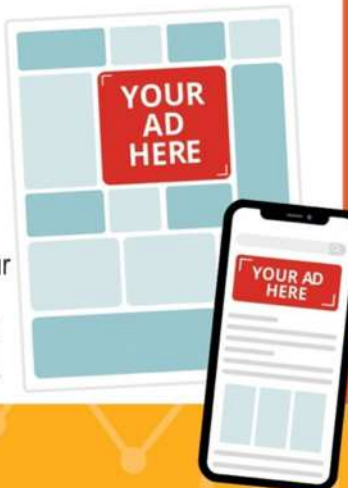

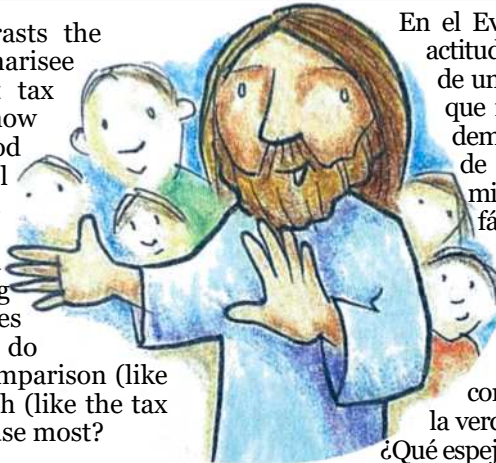

In Sunday's Gospel, Jesus contrasts the self-righteous attitude of the Pharisee with the humility of a penitent tax collector, forcing us to examine how we see other people and how God sees all of us. In God's eyes, all people are worthy of mercy. But he most readily hears those who can acknowledge their failings and pray with a humble heart. During our FFF Community day, families asked themselves, "Which 'mirror' do I use more often, the mirror of comparison (like the pharisee) or the mirror of truth (like the tax collector)?" Which mirror do you use most?



En el Evangelio del domingo, Jesús contrasta la actitud santurrón del fariseo con la humildad de un recaudador de impuestos arrepentido, lo que nos obliga a examinar cómo vemos a los demás y cómo Dios nos ve a todos. A los ojos de Dios, todas las personas son dignas de misericordia. Pero Él escucha más fácilmente a aquellos que pueden reconocer sus fallos y rezar con un corazón humilde. Durante nuestro día de la comunidad FFF, las familias se preguntaron: «¿Qué «espejo» utilizo más a menudo, el espejo de la comparación (como el fariseo) o el espejo de la verdad (como el recaudador de impuestos)?». ¿Qué espejo utilizas más?

God is pleased by our humble prayers. Being humble is a way that we grow in virtue. Virtue is the habit of doing good and wanting to do good. Because of his humble prayer, the tax collector pleased God and was forgiven for his sins. "Prayer is the raising of one's mind and heart to God. . . . humility is the foundation of prayer" (CCC, 2559). "The first movement of the prayer of petition is asking forgiveness, like the tax collector in the parable: 'O God, have mercy on me a sinner'" (CCC, 2631).

A Dios le complacen nuestras oraciones humildes. Ser humildes es una forma de crecer en virtud. La virtud es el hábito de hacer el bien y de querer hacer el bien. Debido a su humilde oración, el recaudador de impuestos agradó a Dios y fue perdonado de sus pecados. "La oración es la elevación del alma a Dios. La humildad es la base de la oración" (CIC, 2559). "La petición de perdón es el primer movimiento de la oración de petición, [como] el publicano de la parábola: 'Oh Dios ten compasión de este pecador'" (CIC, 2631).

Summary of the Readings:

- **First Reading:** Wisdom 3:1-9: The just are safe with God, appearing dead only to the foolish. They are tested like gold and will be greatly blessed. In the future, they will shine and rule, forever guided by God's love and wisdom.
- **Responsorial Psalm:** Psalm 23: The Lord is my shepherd who provides and protects. He leads me through life's challenges and blesses me. I will live in His house forever, surrounded by goodness and kindness.
- **Second Reading:** Romans 6:3-9: Through baptism, we die and rise with Christ, freeing us from sin's grip. This unites us with His resurrection, confirming that death no longer holds power over Him or us.
- **Gospel:** John 6:37-40: Jesus assures that anyone who comes to him will not be turned away. He is doing the will of the Father, which is to lose none that the Father gives him but to raise them up at the last day. Eternal life is promised to those who believe in him.

Reflect:

This Sunday's Gospel comes from the Bread of Life discourse, in which Jesus speaks of eternal life. Jesus does not use limiting terms here. He does not promise eternal life to a select few, but to everyone who believes in him. "I will not reject anyone who comes to me," Jesus says. Eternal life for all believers is more than a teaching; Jesus tells us it is his Father's will that "everyone who sees the Son and believes in him may have eternal life."

- ♦ The Church teaches the communion of all the faithful of Christ, those who are pilgrims on earth (Church Militant), the dead who are being purified (Church Suffering), and the blessed in heaven (Church Triumphant), together forming one Church. How does praying for the dead strengthen your faith in eternal life?
- ♦ Make a list of your loved ones who have died and remember to pray for them throughout the Month of November.
- ♦ Pray Psalm 23.

Resumen de las lecturas:

- **Primera lectura:** Sabiduría 3:1-9: Los justos están a salvo con Dios, y solo parecen muertos a los necios. Son puestos a prueba como el oro y serán grandemente bendecidos. En el futuro, brillarán y gobernarán, guiados para siempre por el amor y la sabiduría de Dios.
- **Salmo responsorial:** Salmo 23: El Señor es mi pastor, que me provee y me protege. Él me guía a través de los desafíos de la vida y me bendice. Viviré en su casa para siempre, rodeado de bondad y amabilidad.
- **Segunda lectura:** Romanos 6:3-9: A través del bautismo, morimos y resucitamos con Cristo, liberándonos del yugo del pecado. Esto nos une a su resurrección, confirmando que la muerte ya no tiene poder sobre Él ni sobre nosotros.
- **Evangelio:** Juan 6:37-40: Jesús asegura que cualquiera que venga a él no será rechazado. Él está haciendo la voluntad del Padre, que es no perder a ninguno de los que el Padre le da, sino resucitarlos en el último día. La vida eterna está prometida a aquellos que creen en él.

Reflejar:

El Evangelio de este domingo proviene del discurso sobre el Pan de Vida, en el que Jesús habla de la vida eterna. Jesús no utiliza aquí términos restrictivos. No promete la vida eterna a unos pocos elegidos, sino a todos los que creen en él. «No rechazaré a nadie que venga a mí», dice Jesús. La vida eterna para todos los creyentes es más que una enseñanza; Jesús nos dice que es la voluntad de su Padre que «todo el que vea al Hijo y crea en él tenga vida eterna».

- ♦ La Iglesia enseña la comunión de todos los fieles de Cristo, los que peregrinan en la tierra (Iglesia militante), los difuntos que se purifican (Iglesia sufridora) y los bien-aventurados en el cielo (Iglesia triunfante), que juntos forman una sola Iglesia. ¿Cómo fortalece tu fe en la vida eterna el hecho de rezar por los difuntos?
- ♦ Haz una lista de tus seres queridos que han fallecido y recuerda rezar por ellos durante todo el mes de noviembre.
- ♦ Reza el Salmo 23.

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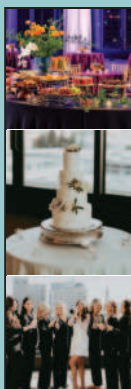
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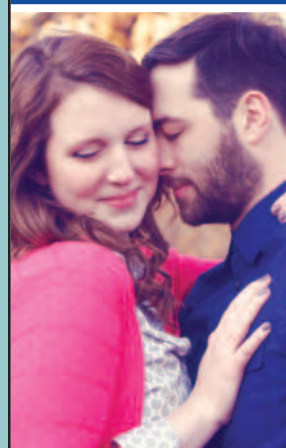
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
