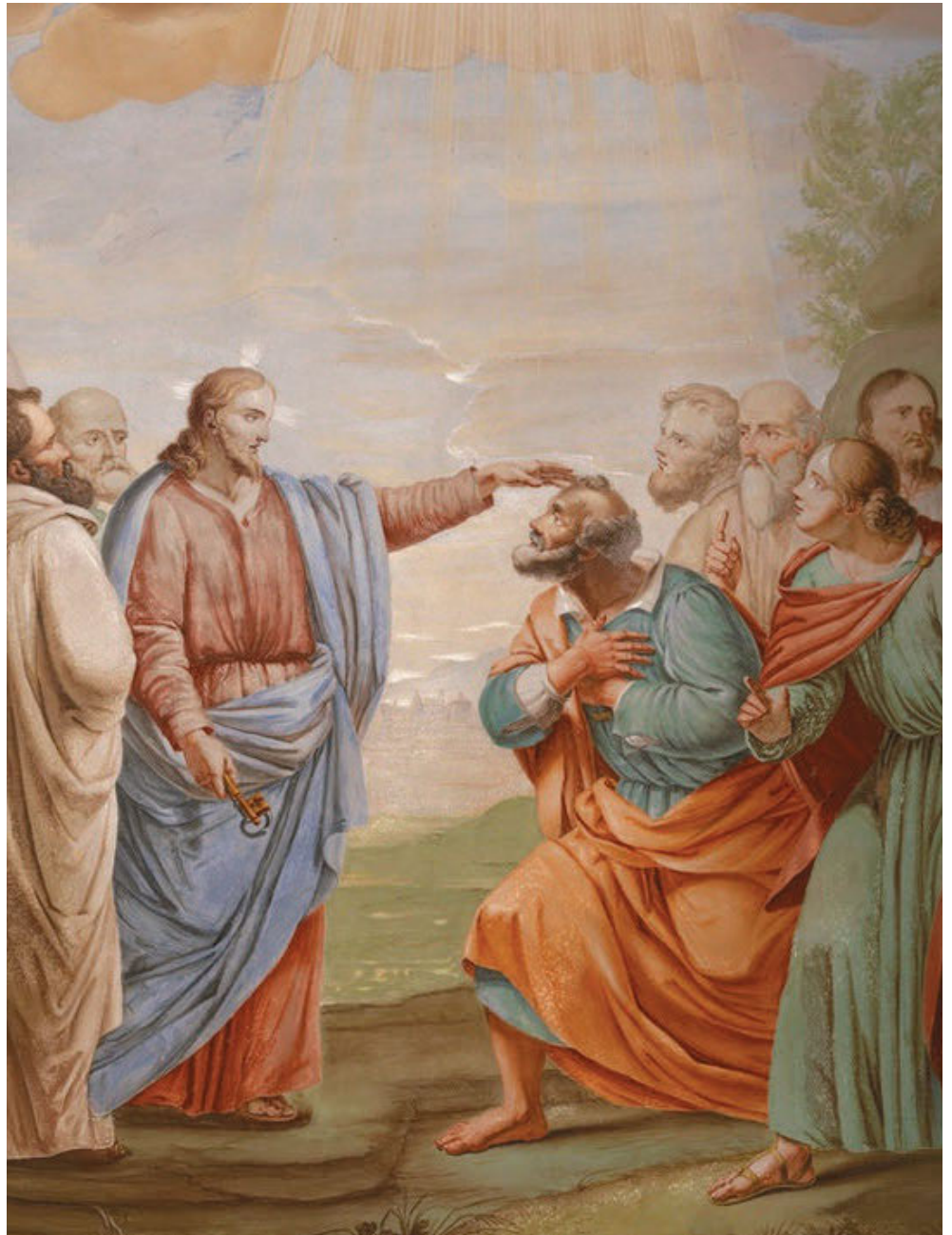

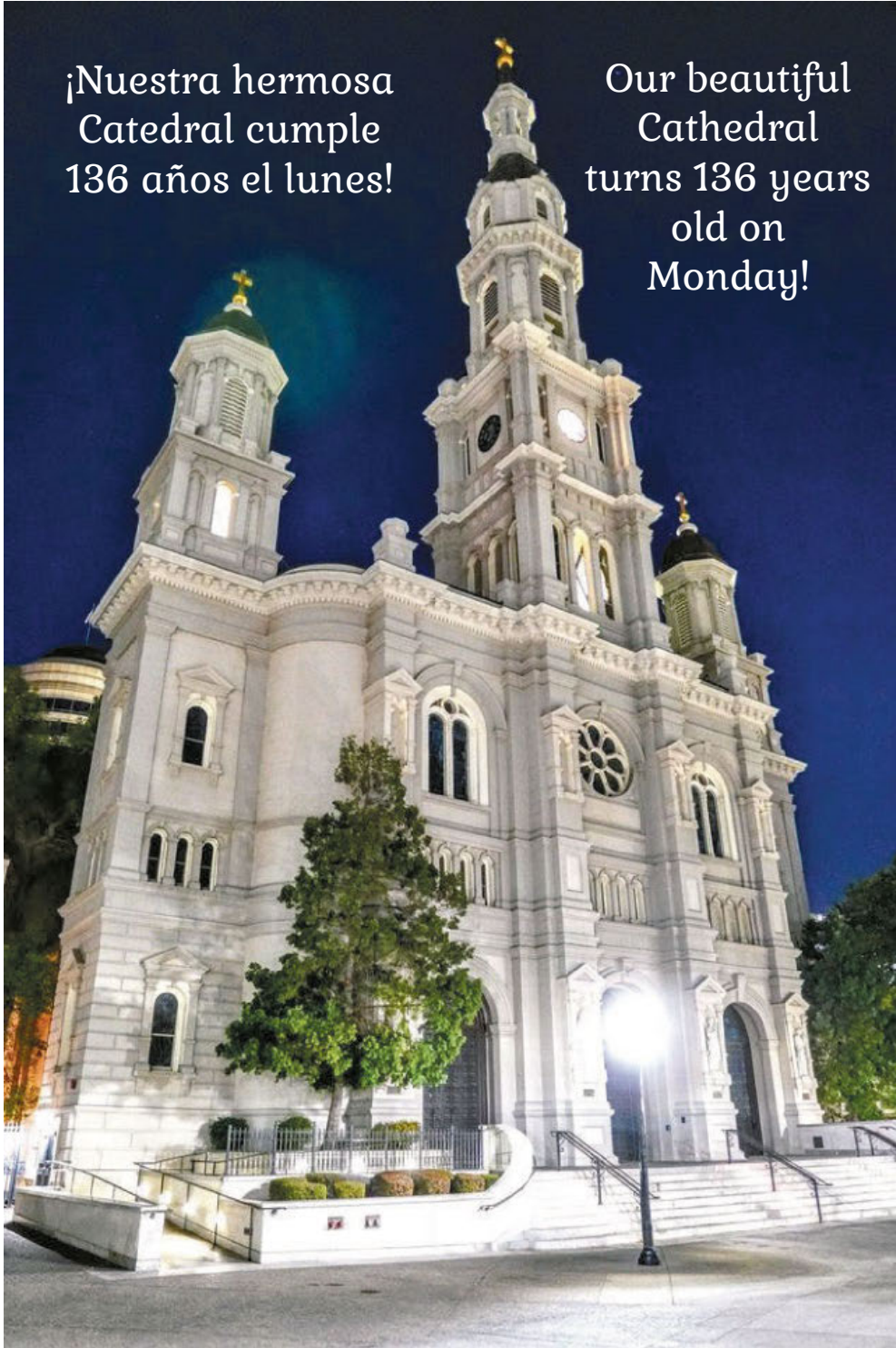

On Monday, June 30, we celebrate the 136th Anniversary of the Dedication of the Cathedral. **Donate generously next Sunday, July 6 to our 1st Sunday Special Collection for Repairs and Maintenance.** Our focus is restoration of art, particularly the Gospel Saints at the base of the rotunda. The goal is \$150,000 because we need to hire expensive scaffolding. So far we have reached 45% of our target and ask you to continue giving to commemorate the anniversary of our beautiful place of worship.

An Evening of Sacred Music and Jazz: “To Hope! A Celebration”

The Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament is honored to welcome the Chris Brubeck Trio, featuring acclaimed pianist Joe Gilman, for a special performance of *To Hope! A Celebration* on **Friday, July 11**. This unique concert blends classical structure with the distinctive jazz style of the legendary Dave Brubeck.

Dave Brubeck, a native of Northern California, had deep ties to the Sacramento region. In 1983, he performed *To Hope! A Celebration* at our Cathedral, along with *Pange Lingua Variations*, a piece commissioned by the Cathedral and joyfully revived here last summer.

This year’s concert features Dave’s sons—Grammy-nominated musicians Chris and Dan Brubeck—joined by Joe Gilman, guest soloists Omari Tau, Jeanette Blakeney, the Very Rev. Michael O’Reilly; and the Cathedral Choir and Orchestra. The program will be conducted by Ryan Murray and will also include *A Celebration of Love and Joy* by André Thomas, a vibrant and uplifting work in the Gospel tradition. Following the concert, guests are invited to an optional reception with wine and hors d’oeuvres at Brasserie du Monde, located at 1201 K Street, one block from the Cathedral. We are grateful to Brasserie du Monde for their generous sponsorship of this event.

Proceeds from the concert event will fund Restoration of Cathedral Art.

Pilgrims of Hope: Believing the Gospel, Living it extraordinarily

Today the Church celebrates the two great Apostles, Saints Peter and Paul. Together, these two saints are considered the founders of the See of Rome, through their preaching, ministry and martyrdom in the Holy City. Although Peter and Paul are great saints, they were also ordinary men called to extraordinary vocations. They responded and God used them in ways they could have never imagined. **All of us are called to live out our baptism with the same resolve to embrace our holy mission.** And you can be part of the current mission here at the Cathedral. The headlines in recent months have shown a huge growth in Google searches of "how to become Catholic", surging to a staggering 373% in April. Our Family Faith Formation, OCIA and Evangelization Office has had an increase of young people inquiring about the Catholic Church and how to become Catholic and receive Sacraments. We are called to answer this interest by asking ourselves, "How can I help? We need more volunteers who believe in the Gospel to become not only as teachers of the faith, but want to help us welcome and walk with seekers. **YOU** are essential to **help us answer the question: "How do I become Catholic?"**

Necesitamos más voluntarios que crean en el Evangelio para convertirse no sólo en maestros de la fe, sino que quieran ayudarnos a acoger y caminar con los que buscan. **USTED** es esencial para **ayudarnos a responder a la pregunta: «¿Cómo me hago católico?»**

Focus of the Gospel:

As the Church returns to “Ordinary Time”, our readings reflect anything but ordinary. Our Gospel next Sunday recounts the sending of the “72 others” whom Jesus sent ahead of him to prepare the people for His coming. They returned after their mission rejoicing because they found that because of Jesus’ name they were able to do amazing signs before the people, having been given power to “tread upon serpents”. At every Catholic Mass, we too are sent with the power of God. In the Latin, text the concluding words are “Ite, missa est”. This translates to “Go, the Mass is ended”. With these words, we are not simply dismissed, but rather we are SENT FORTH on a mission to live out the Gospel in the world. How is Jesus calling YOU to live the Gospel in your daily life? During the month of July life slows down just a bit. It is a good time to consider taking up a way of helping others. It is also a good time to take up a practice of prayer—or maybe going to Mass during the week—so to nourish your soul with God’s Word and with God’s Flesh in communion. We need this nourishment so to accept the sending and go out from our homes and churches to feed a world so in need of God’s message of love. Are you ready to go serve?

Reflect:

- ◆ Imagine yourself with Jesus. He dismisses you to go out and bring His message to others. What do you do when you go out?
- ◆ Have you ever shared your faith, feeling God working through you?
- ◆ Do you want to be a Disciple and need help getting started?

Enfoque del evangelio:

Al volver la Iglesia al «Tiempo Ordinario», nuestras lecturas reflejan cualquier cosa menos ordinaria. Nuestro Evangelio del próximo domingo narra el envío de los «otros 72» que Jesús envió delante de él para preparar al pueblo para su venida. Después de su misión, regresaron regocijados, porque descubrieron que, gracias al nombre de Jesús, podían realizar signos asombrosos ante la gente, pues se les había dado poder para «pisotear serpientes». En cada Misa católica, también nosotros somos enviados con el poder de Dios. En cada Misa católica, también nosotros somos enviados. En el texto latino, las palabras finales son «Ite, missa est». Esto se traduce como «Vete, la misa ha terminado». Con estas palabras, no se nos despide simplemente, sino que se nos ENVÍA a una misión para vivir el Evangelio en el mundo. ¿Cómo te llama Jesús a vivir el Evangelio en tu vida diaria? Durante el mes de julio la vida se ralentiza un poco. Es un buen momento para plantearse una forma de ayudar a los demás. También es un buen momento para practicar la oración -o tal vez ir a Misa durante la semana- para alimentar tu alma con la Palabra de Dios y con la Carne de Dios en comunión. Necesitamos este alimento para aceptar el envío y salir de nuestros hogares e iglesias para alimentar a un mundo tan necesitado del mensaje de amor de Dios. ¿Estás listo para ir a servir?

Reflejar:

- ◆ Imagínate con Jesús. Él te despide para que salgas y lleves Su mensaje a los demás. ¿Qué haces cuando sales?
- ◆ ¿Alguna vez has compartido tu fe con otros sintiendo a Dios obrando a través de ti?
- ◆ ¿Quieres ser discípulo y necesitas ayuda para empezar?

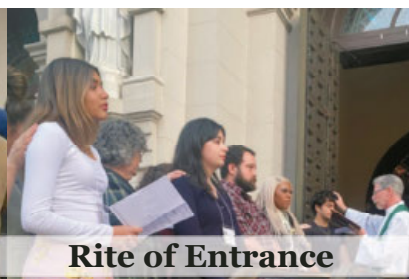

Liturgy of the Word

Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles June 29, 2025

READING I ACTS 12:1-11

In those days, King Herod laid hands upon some members of the Church to harm them. He had James, the brother of John, killed by the sword, and when he saw that this was pleasing to the Jews he proceeded to arrest Peter also. –It was the feast of Unleavened Bread. –He had him taken into custody and put in prison under the guard of four squads of four soldiers each. He intended to bring him before the people after Passover. Peter thus was being kept in prison, but prayer by the Church was fervently being made to God on his behalf.

On the very night before Herod was to bring him to trial, Peter, secured by double chains, was sleeping between two soldiers, while outside the door guards kept watch on the prison. Suddenly the angel of the Lord stood by him and a light shone in the cell. He tapped Peter on the side and awakened him, saying, “Get up quickly.” The chains fell from his wrists. The angel said to him, “Put on your belt and your sandals.” He did so. Then he said to him, “Put on your cloak and follow me.” So he followed him out, not realizing that what was happening through the angel was real; he thought he was seeing a vision. They passed the first guard, then the second, and came to the iron gate leading out to the city, which opened for them by itself. They emerged and made their way down an alley, and suddenly the angel left him. Then Peter recovered his senses and said, “Now I know for certain that the Lord sent his angel and rescued me from the hand of Herod and from all that the Jewish people had been expecting.”

I, Paul, am already being poured out like a libation, and the time of my departure is at hand. I have competed well; I have finished the race; I have kept the faith. From now on the crown of righteousness awaits me, which the Lord, the just judge, will award to me on that day, and not only to me, but to all who have longed for his appearance. The Lord stood by me and gave me strength, so that through me the proclamation might be completed and all the Gentiles might hear it. And I was rescued from the lion's mouth. The Lord will rescue me from every evil threat and will bring me safe to his heavenly Kingdom. To him be glory forever and ever. Amen.

SOLEMNIDAD DE SAN PEDRO Y SAN PABLO, APÓSTOLES 29 de junio de 2025

PRIMERA LECTURA **HECHOS 12, 1-11**

En aquellos días, el rey Herodes mandó apresar a algunos miembros de la Iglesia para maltratarlos. Mandó pasar a cuchillo a Santiago, hermano de Juan, y viendo que eso agradaSSSba a los judíos, también hizo apresar a Pedro. Esto sucedió durante los días de la fiesta de los panes Ázimos. Después de apresarlo, lo hizo encarcelar y lo puso bajo la vigilancia de cuatro turnos de guardia, de cuatro soldados cada turno. Su intención era hacerlo comparecer ante el pueblo después de la Pascua. Mientras Pedro estaba en la cárcel, la comunidad no cesaba de orar a Dios por él.

La noche anterior al día en que Herodes iba a hacerlo comparecer ante el pueblo, Pedro estaba durmiendo entre dos soldados, atado con dos cadenas y los centinelas cuidaban la puerta de la prisión. De pronto apareció el ángel del Señor y el calabozo se llenó de luz. El ángel tocó a Pedro en el costado, lo despertó y le dijo: “Levántate pronto”. Entonces las cadenas que le sujetaban las manos se le cayeron. El ángel le dijo: “Cíñete la túnica y ponte las sandalias”, y Pedro obedeció. Después le dijo: “Ponte el manto y sígueme”. Pedro salió detrás de él, sin saber si era verdad o no lo que el ángel hacía, y le parecía más bien que estaba soñando. Pasaron el primero y el segundo puesto de guardia y llegaron a la puerta de hierro que daba a la calle. La puerta se abrió sola delante de ellos. Salieron y caminaron hasta la esquina de la calle y de pronto el ángel desapareció.

Entonces, Pedro se dio cuenta de lo que pasaba y dijo: “Ahora sí estoy seguro de que el Señor envió a su ángel para librarme de las manos de Herodes y de todo cuanto el pueblo judío esperaba que me hicieran”.
