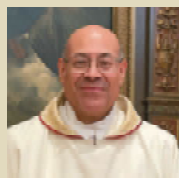

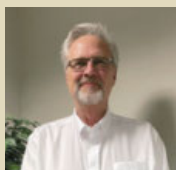

Most Holy Body & Blood of Jesus

*“Take, eat:
this is my body ...
Drink of it...
this is my blood ...”*

Matthew 26:26-28

Pilgrims of Hope: The Holy Eucharist is the Bread for the Journey.

Today the Church honors Jesus with the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus, historically known as the feast of Corpus Christi. When we approach the Altar at communion and the minister says “The Body of Christ” (Corpus Christi in Latin), we respond, “Amen!” , that is, “Yes, I believe!” As Catholics, we believe that the small host held up is truly the Body and Blood of Jesus. God made flesh. One of Sr Lisa Marie’s favorite stories regarding Eucharistic Miracles took place in the coastal town of Tumaco, Colombia on January 31, 1906. There was a strong earthquake that triggered a tsunami in the Pacific Ocean. The town of Tumaco was in the path of the coming wall of water! Father Larrondo raised the consecrated Host and made the Sign of the Cross over the water. Miraculously, the immense wave halted and began to sink back into the sea, sparing the town. The Miracle of Tumaco is a testament to the belief of the Real Presence of Jesus Christ (God) in the Blessed Sacrament and the divine intervention through faith and prayer.



Hoy la Iglesia honra a Jesús con la Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Jesús, conocida históricamente como la fiesta del Corpus Christi. Cuando nos acercamos al Altar en la comunión y el ministro dice «El Cuerpo de Cristo» (Corpus Christi en latín), respondemos: «¡Amén!». , es decir, «¡Sí, creo!». Como católicos, creemos que la pequeña hostia que se sostiene es verdaderamente el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús. Dios hecho carne. Una de las historias favoritas de Sr Lisa Marie sobre Milagros Eucarísticos tuvo lugar en la ciudad costera de Tumaco, Colombia, el 31 de enero de 1906. Hubo un fuerte terremoto que provocó un tsunami en el Océano Pacífico. La ciudad de Tumaco se encontraba en la trayectoria del muro de agua que se avecinaba. El Padre Larrondo levantó la Hostia consagrada e hizo la Señal de la Cruz sobre el agua. Milagrosamente, la inmensa ola se detuvo y comenzó a hundirse en el mar, salvando a la ciudad. El Milagro de Tumaco es un testimonio de la creencia en la Presencia Real de Jesucristo (Dios) en el Santísimo Sacramento y de la intervención divina a través de la fe y la oración.

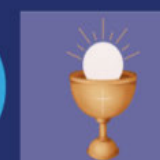

**Prepare: Solemnity
Saints Peter and Paul**

Acts 12:1-11

Psalm 34:2-3, 4-5, 6-7, 8-9

2 Timothy 4:6-8, 17-18

Matthew 16:13-19

Focus of the Gospel:

The lives of Saints Peter and Paul show that faith can grow even in people who make mistakes or face great challenges. Peter was impulsive and sometimes afraid, but he became a strong leader in the Church. Paul started as an enemy of Christians, yet he became a great missionary. Their stories remind us that no matter where we begin, we can grow in faith and serve God in amazing ways.

Peter teaches us about trusting God even when it is hard. He walked on water when Jesus called him, but he began to sink when he doubted. He denied Jesus out of fear but later had the courage to preach about Him in front of powerful leaders. His life shows that faith is a journey. It reminds us that it's okay to stumble as long as we keep trusting God and trying to follow Him.

Paul's life shows how God can change hearts and give us a new purpose. Paul thought he was doing the right thing by persecuting Christians, but he was willing to listen when Jesus called him. After his conversion, he used all his energy to spread the Gospel. His story challenges us to reflect on our own lives. Are we open to change? Are we listening for God's call, even if it leads us somewhere unexpected?

Both Peter and Paul show us how to be courageous in sharing our faith. They faced prison, hardship, and death because they loved Jesus and wanted others to know Him. Their courage encourages us to think about how we live our faith. Do we share it with others? Do we trust God when things get hard?

Reflect:

- ◆ How does Peter's story encourage you to trust God, even after mistakes?
- ◆ Are there areas in your life where you feel God calling you to change, like Paul?
- ◆ How can you show courage in living and sharing your faith with others?
- ◆ Pray Psalm 34:2-9

Enfoque del evangelio:

Las vidas de los santos Pedro y Pablo demuestran que la fe puede crecer incluso en personas que cometen errores o se enfrentan a grandes retos. Pedro era impulsivo y a veces temeroso, pero se convirtió en un fuerte líder de la Iglesia. Pablo empezó siendo enemigo de los cristianos, pero se convirtió en un gran misionero. Sus historias nos recuerdan que, empecemos donde empecemos, podemos crecer en la fe y servir a Dios de forma asombrosa.

Pedro nos enseña a confiar en Dios incluso cuando es difícil. Caminó sobre las aguas cuando Jesús le llamó, pero empezó a hundirse cuando dudó. Negó a Jesús por miedo, pero más tarde tuvo el valor de predicar sobre Él delante de poderosos líderes. Su vida demuestra que la fe es un viaje. Nos recuerda que está bien tropezar siempre que sigamos confiando en Dios y tratando de seguirle.

La vida de Pablo muestra cómo Dios puede cambiar los corazones y darnos un nuevo propósito. Pablo pensaba que estaba haciendo lo correcto al perseguir a los cristianos, pero estaba dispuesto a escuchar cuando Jesús lo llamó. Tras su conversión, empleó toda su energía en difundir el Evangelio. Su historia nos desafía a reflexionar sobre nuestras propias vidas. ¿Estamos abiertos al cambio? ¿Escuchamos la llamada de Dios, aunque nos lleve a un lugar inesperado?

Tanto Pedro como Pablo nos muestran cómo ser valientes al compartir nuestra fe. Se enfrentaron a la cárcel, a penurias y a la muerte porque amaban a Jesús y querían que otros lo conocieran. Su valentía nos anima a pensar en cómo vivimos nuestra fe. ¿La compartimos con los demás? ¿Confiamos en Dios cuando las cosas se ponen difíciles?

Reflejar:

- ◆ ¿Cómo te anima la historia de Pedro a confiar en Dios, incluso después de cometer errores?
- ◆ ¿Hay aspectos de tu vida en los que sientes que Dios te llama a cambiar, como a Pablo?
- ◆ ¿Cómo puedes mostrar valentía al vivir y compartir tu fe con los demás?
- ◆ Reza Salmo 34:2-9

Now the men there numbered about five thousand. Then he said to his disciples, "Have them sit down in groups of about fifty." They did so and made them all sit down. Then taking the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, he said the blessing over them, broke them, and gave them to the disciples to set before the crowd. They all ate and were satisfied. And when the leftover fragments were picked up, they filled twelve wicker baskets.

Comieron todos y se saciaron, y de lo que sobró se llenaron doce canastos.
