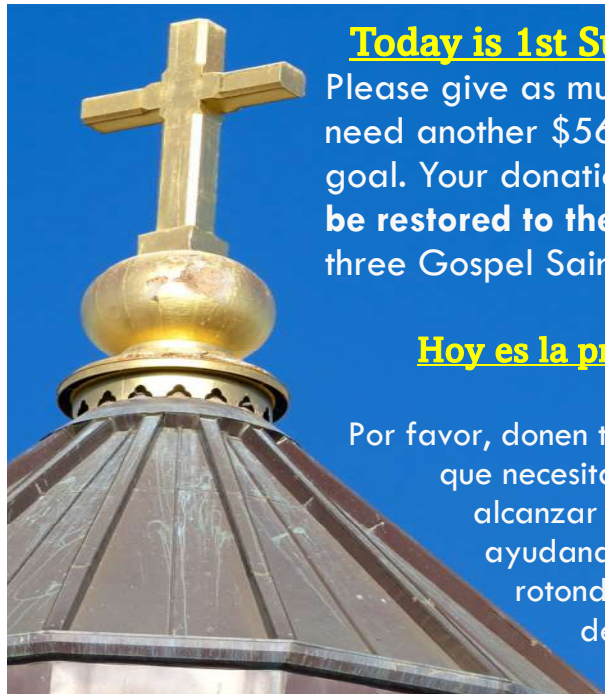

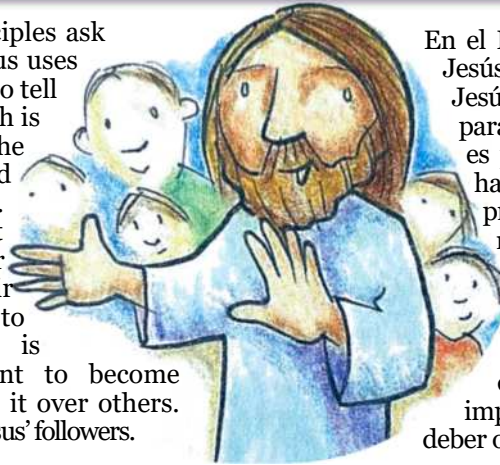

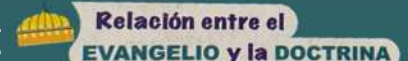
In Sunday's Gospel, Jesus' disciples ask him to increase their faith. Jesus uses the example of a mustard seed to tell them that even a little bit of faith is powerful. Faith in Jesus gives the power to perform miracles and to recognize those we witness. In Jesus' time, masters didn't sit down to eat with servants or reward them for doing their jobs. Jesus used this reality to make a point. His parable is critical of disciples who want to become masters of their fate or to lord it over others. Service is the ordinary duty of all Jesus' followers.



En el Evangelio del domingo, los discípulos de Jesús le pidieron que les aumentara su fe. Jesús usa el ejemplo de la semilla de mostaza para explicarles que, incluso un poquito de fe, es poderosa. La fe en Jesús da el poder de hacer milagros y reconocer a aquellos que presenciamos. En los tiempos de Jesús, los maestros no se sentaban a comer con los siervos ni los premiaban por hacer su trabajo. Jesús usó esta realidad para señalar un punto en particular. Su parábola es crítica para los discípulos que quieren hacerse maestros de su fe o imponerla sobre los demás. El servicio es el deber ordinario de todos los seguidores de Jesús.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus' friends ask for more faith. Jesus wants his disciples to understand that faith doesn't come in amounts like money. Faith is knowing that we can count on God's faithfulness. We receive our faith as a gift and are expected to share it with others. Faith is both personal and public. We proclaim our faith when we pray our Creed: I believe!

Summary of the Readings:

- **First Reading** – 2 Kings 5:14-17: Naaman was healed of leprosy after obeying Elisha's instruction. He acknowledged the God of Israel and vowed to worship only Him. Elisha refused Naaman's gift.
- **Responsorial Psalm** – Psalm 98: The Lord has shown his saving power and justice to all nations. Sing a new song and praise him for his wonderful deeds and faithfulness.
- **Second Reading** – 2 Timothy 2:8-13: Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead. I suffer for the gospel, but God's word is free. Endure for salvation in Christ. If we are unfaithful, he remains faithful.
- **Gospel** – Luke 17:11-19: Ten lepers asked Jesus for mercy. As they went to show themselves to the priests, they were healed. Only one, a Samaritan, returned to thank Jesus. Jesus praised his faith.

Reflect:

After Jesus cleanses 10 lepers, Jesus asked, "Ten were cleansed ... where are the other nine?" Only one—an outsider—returned to show gratitude for the good done to him. We should follow the thankful leper's example. When we come to the Eucharist—which literally means 'thanksgiving' – do we offer our thanks and praise to God for the good He has done for us and our families?

- ♦ Why do you think only one leper returned to thank Jesus? What lesson can you learn from his example?
- ♦ How can you practice gratitude in your daily life?
- ♦ Jesus showed mercy on all ten lepers. What are some ways you have experienced God's mercy?
- ♦ How are you called to show mercy to others?
- ♦ Pray with Psalm 98.

Resumen de las lecturas:

- **Primera lectura** – 2 Reyes 5:14-17: Naamán se curó de la lepra tras obedecer las instrucciones de Eliseo. Reconoció al Dios de Israel y juró adorarlo solo a Él. Eliseo rechazó el regalo de Naamán.
- **Salmo responsorial** – Salmo 98: El Señor ha mostrado su poder salvador y su justicia a todas las naciones. Cantad un cántico nuevo y alabadlo por sus maravillosas obras y su fidelidad.
- **Segunda lectura** – 2 Timoteo 2:8-13: Recordad a Jesucristo, resucitado de entre los muertos. Yo sufro por el evangelio, pero la palabra de Dios es gratuita. Perseverad por la salvación en Cristo. Si somos infieles, Él permanece fiel.
- **Evangelio** – Lucas 17:11-19: Diez leprosos pidieron misericordia a Jesús. Mientras iban a mostrarse a los sacerdotes, fueron curados. Solo uno, un samaritano, volvió para dar las gracias a Jesús. Jesús alabó su fe.

Reflejar:

Después de limpiar a diez leprosos, Jesús preguntó: «Diez fueron limpiados... ¿dónde están los otros nueve?». Solo uno, un forastero, regresó para mostrar su gratitud por el bien que se le había hecho. Debemos seguir el ejemplo del leproso agradecido. Cuando acudimos a la Eucaristía, que literalmente significa «acción de gracias», ¿ofrecemos nuestro agradecimiento y alabanza a Dios por el bien que ha hecho por nosotros y nuestras familias?

- ♦ ¿Por qué crees que solo uno de los leprosos regresó para darle las gracias a Jesús? ¿Qué lección puedes aprender de su ejemplo?
- ♦ ¿Cómo puedes practicar la gratitud en tu vida diaria?
- ♦ Jesús mostró misericordia a los diez leprosos. ¿De qué maneras has experimentado la misericordia de Dios?
- ♦ ¿Cómo estás llamado a mostrar misericordia a los demás? Reza con el Salmo 98.

TWENTY-SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME OCTOBER 5, 2025

READING 1

HAB 1:2-3; 2:2-4

How long, O LORD? I cry for help but you do not listen! I cry out to you, "Violence!" but you do not intervene. Why do you let me see ruin; why must I look at misery? Destruction and violence are before me; there is strife, and clamorous discord. Then the LORD answered me and said: Write down the vision clearly upon the tablets, so that one can read it readily. For the vision still has its time, presses on to fulfillment, and will not disappoint; if it delays, wait for it, it will surely come, it will not be late. The rash one has no integrity; but the just one, because of his faith, shall live.

Beloved:

So do not be ashamed of your testimony to our Lord, nor of me, a prisoner for his sake; but bear your share of hardship for the gospel with the strength that comes from God.

Take as your norm the sound words that you heard from me, in the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus. Guard this rich trust with the help of the Holy Spirit that dwells within us.

GOSPEL LK 17:5-10

The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith." The Lord replied, "If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you.

"Who among you would say to your servant who has just come in from plowing or tending sheep in the field, 'Come here immediately and take your place at table'? Would he not rather say to him, 'Prepare something for me to eat. Put on your apron and wait on me while I eat and drink. You may eat and drink when I am finished'? Is he grateful to that servant because he did what was commanded? So should it be with you. When you have done all you have been commanded, say, 'We are unprofitable servants; we have done what we were obliged to do.'"

PRIMERA LECTURA **HAB 1, 2-3; 2, 2-4**

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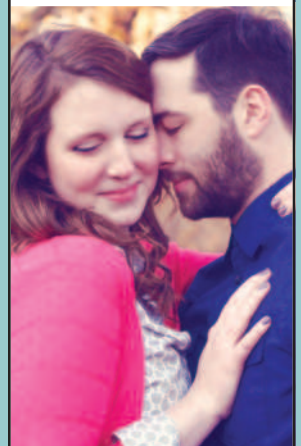
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
