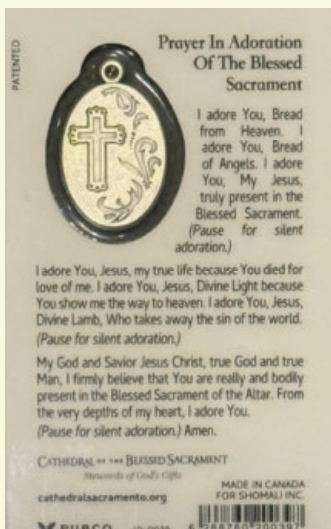
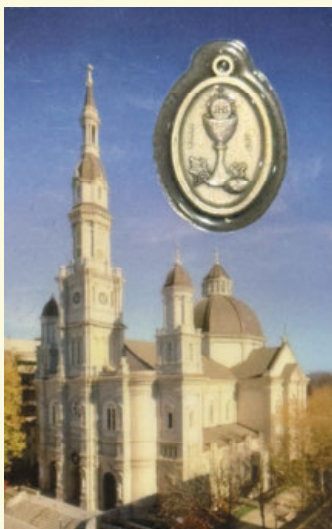

Most Holy Trinity

Go...baptizing in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. - Matthew 28:19

Pilgrims of Hope: The Holy Trinity is a Model for our Families.

Today the Church honors the Most Holy Trinity: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Three Divine Persons—One Holy God. The Trinity was revealed numerous times in the Gospels, most directly by Jesus Christ. Jesus often prayed to the Father, and the Father revealed Jesus as his beloved son at the Baptism in the Jordan and again at the Transfiguration. We just heard last week how Jesus sent his Apostles after giving them the Holy Spirit. The Holy Trinity is an example of perfect unity and harmony of the three different persons but one and the same God is often seen as a model for families and communities in the Catechism and in Theology (the study of God). In our human relationships, we will never be perfect but we can respond to our call to be open and ready to listen and understand the other. Every time we make the Sign of the Cross we become more aware of the presence of the Holy Trinity. As families of faith, let us work to integrate the loving relationship of the Holy Trinity in our Family Life.



Hoy la Iglesia honra a la Santísima Trinidad: Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Tres Personas Divinas - Un Dios Santo. La Trinidad fue revelada numerosas veces en los Evangelios, más directamente por Jesucristo. Jesús oró a menudo al Padre, y el Padre reveló a Jesús como su hijo amado en el Bautismo en el Jordán y de nuevo en la Transfiguración. Acabamos de oír la semana pasada cómo Jesús envió a sus Apóstoles después de darles el Espíritu Santo. La Santísima Trinidad es un ejemplo de perfecta unidad y armonía de las tres personas diferentes, pero un mismo Dios, que a menudo se ve como modelo para las familias y las comunidades en el Catecismo y en la Teología (el estudio de Dios). En nuestras relaciones humanas, nunca seremos perfectos, pero podemos responder a nuestra llamada a estar abiertos y dispuestos a escuchar y comprender al otro. Cada vez que hacemos la Señal de la Cruz nos hacemos más conscientes de la presencia de la Santísima Trinidad. Como familias de fe, trabajemos para integrar la relación de amor de la Santísima Trinidad en nuestra vida familiar.

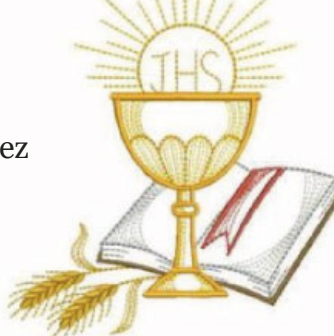

Focus of the Gospel:

The Solemnity of Corpus Christi celebrates the gift of the Eucharist and reminds us of God's love and the unity of the Church through the Body and Blood of Christ. In the month of June at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament (we are named after the precious body and blood of Jesus!), we celebrate a lot of Sacraments: Baptisms (the door to all the Sacraments), Confirmations, 1st Communion, Marriages, Ordinations and Reconciliations. All the Sacraments have their meaning because Jesus gave us Himself—the Bread of Life. Sundays we gather to honor God and give thanks incidentally, the Greek word "Eucharistia" means thanksgiving. And that is precisely what we as Catholics do each time the Mass is celebrated; we give thanks to God for His goodness to us. Take time this week and reflect on the Gift of the Eucharist in your family.

Reflect:

- ♦ Jesus gives us His very self in saying, "This is my Body ... this is my Blood." What does this tell you about His love for all humanity? For you personally?
- ♦ We are sent at the end of Mass to serve. How are you serving?
- ♦ Pray Psalm 110: 1-4

Enfoque del evangelio:

La solemnidad del Corpus Christi celebra el don de la Eucaristía y nos recuerda el amor de Dios y la unidad de la Iglesia a través del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. En el mes de junio en la Catedral del Santísimo Sacramento (inos llamamos así por el precioso cuerpo y sangre de Jesús!), celebramos muchos Sacramentos: Bautismos (la puerta a todos los Sacramentos), Confirmaciones, Primeras Comuniones, Matrimonios, Ordenaciones y Reconciliaciones. Todos los Sacramentos tienen su significado porque Jesús se nos dio a Sí mismo: el Pan de Vida. Los domingos nos reunimos para honrar a Dios y dar gracias por cierto, la palabra griega «Eucharistia» significa acción de gracias. Y eso es precisamente lo que hacemos los católicos cada vez que celebramos la Misa: damos gracias a Dios por su bondad para con nosotros. Dedica un tiempo esta semana a reflexionar sobre el don de la Eucaristía en tu familia.

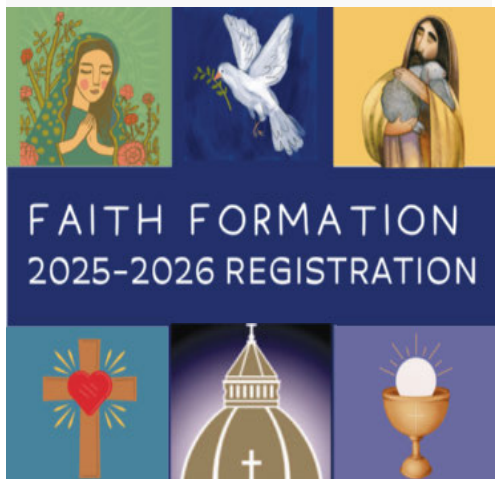

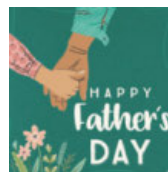

SOLEMNIDAD DE LA SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD 15 de junio de 2025

Primera Lectura Prov 8, 22-31

Esto dice la sabiduría de Dios: “El Señor me poseía desde el principio, antes que sus obras más antiguas. Quedé establecida desde la eternidad, desde el principio, antes de que la tierra existiera. 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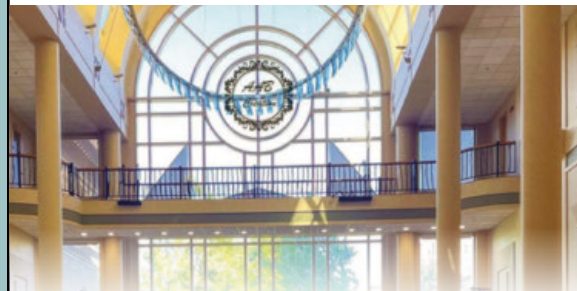
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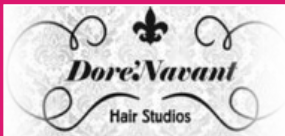
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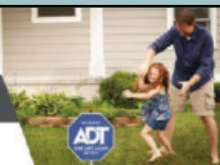
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
