Stewardship Reflection

Though we can never fully grasp the infinite perfection of God and His ways, a basic knowledge of Scripture reveals that God's logic often differs from worldly logic.

Our first reading, from Isaiah, reminds us that God often thinks bigger than we do. "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways, says the LORD. As high as the heavens are above the earth, so high are my ways above your ways and my thoughts above your thoughts." As His followers we must strive as best we can to think as God does, using our time (and our talents and treasure, too) with eternity in mind.

In our Gospel passage from Matthew, Jesus offers us a glimpse of the "Godly logic" of the Father through a parable of a landowner hiring workers for his vineyard. Some workers are called early in the day, others not until very late. Yet the landowner pays them all a full day's wage. This angered the laborers who had worked longest. But those laborers were relying on human logic and human calculations. They were not thinking as God does.

This can happen to us Christian stewards as well. We can grumble and complain (at least internally) when we compare ourselves to others and sense that not everyone is contributing as much as we are to the parish, the neighborhood, within our family and so on. At those moments, we need to think bigger!

We must remember that it is a great privilege to have been called by the Father to work in His vineyard. Living the stewardship way of life brings us meaning, depth and purpose.

Let's embrace this Godly thinking and thank Him for calling us to this way of life.



Jesus told his disciples this parable:

"The kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out at dawn to hire laborers for his vineyard. After agreeing with them for the usual daily wage, he sent them into his vineyard. Going out about nine o'clock, the landowner saw others standing idle in the marketplace, and he said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard, and I will give you what is just.' So they went off. And he went out again around noon, and around three o'clock, and did likewise. Going out about five o'clock, the landowner found others standing around, and said to them, 'Why do you stand here idle all day?' They answered, 'Because no one has hired us.' He said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard!' When it was evening the owner of the vineyard said to his foreman, 'Summon the laborers and give them their pay, beginning with the last and ending with the first.' When those who had started about five o'clock came, each received the usual daily wage. So when the first came, they thought that they would receive more, but each of them also got the usual wage. And on receiving it they grumbled against the landowner, saying, 'These last ones worked only one hour, and you have made them equal to us, who bore the day's burden and the heat.' He said to one of them in reply, 'My friend, I am not cheating you. Did you not agree with me for the usual daily wage? Take what is yours and go. What if I wish to give this last one the same as you? Or am I not free to do as I wish with my own money? Are you envious because I am generous?' Thus, the last will be first, and the first will be last."

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

A Glimpse of Spirituality 瞬間靈修 (John 若6:52-59)

After having done the miracle, Jesus continued to speak of himself as the bread of life, but added that the bread he would supply was his flesh given for the life of the world. In other words, it is only by coming to Jesus and living in union with him that people may attain eternal life.

This living, however, is possible only in virtue of a twofold divine initiative: (1) Jesus has come down from heaven as the bread of life, and which supplies life to those who assimilate it; (2) God draws to Jesus all those who are to be united with him in eternal life. That is to say, humans' eternal life is achieved by participating in the life of Jesus since the bread of heaven is the flesh of Jesus, which gives life to the world; and there is no life for the world in any other source.

Jesus said, "He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day." Flesh and blood are introduced to emphasize that it is the whole incarnate life of Jesus. The Christian life, as a matter of fact, is a mediated life in which we mediate eternal life to the world by eating and drinking Jesus's flesh and blood. The two verbs of "eat" (trōgōn) and "drink" (pinōn) insist on concrete actions, in particular "eat" in the Greek understanding is to crunch or chew the food. It is a human action showing the commitment of life into the life of Jesus.

The divine action runs throughout the whole process, from the initial coming to the last day, when Jesus himself will raise up the believer who is thus dependent on him from beginning to end. We share in his divine life, which is an assurance of eternal life and the basis for the conviction that we are children of God. God shares life through Jesus and with all other people.

Christ is the head and we are the body. Together we are one. That which unites us with him and with each other is our willingness to offer our lives for our fellow-members in Christ's mystical body.

然而，永生只有在天主恩寵下才能獲得：(1)耶穌作為從天降下的生命之糧，是將永生賜予那些領受的人；(2)天主引領所有在永生中與祂共融的人歸向耶穌。也就是說，人的永生是通過參與耶穌的生命而實現，因為天上的食糧是耶穌的身體，賦予世界生命；世界上沒有任何其他永生來源。

耶穌說：“誰吃我的肉，並喝我的血，必得永生，在末日，我且要叫他復活。”血肉強調耶穌降生成人的整個生命。基督徒的生活，事實上是媒介，通過吃喝耶穌的肉和血，給世界傳遞永生。

“吃” (trōgōn) 和 “喝” (pinōn) 這兩個動詞強調具體的動作，特別是 “吃” 在希臘語中的理解，是咬碎或咀嚼食物；這行為表明人的生命委身於耶穌的生命。

天主的行動貫穿於整個過程，從耶穌降生一直到世界末日，耶穌親自帶領一切跟隨他的信徒。當信徒分享耶穌神聖生命，是永生的保證，也是我們確信自己是天主子女的基礎。簡言之，天主通過耶穌和所有信徒分享生命。

基督是頭，信徒是身體，因此天人合一。能使我們與耶穌共融的，是願意為基督奧體中的成員奉獻我們生命。

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
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
