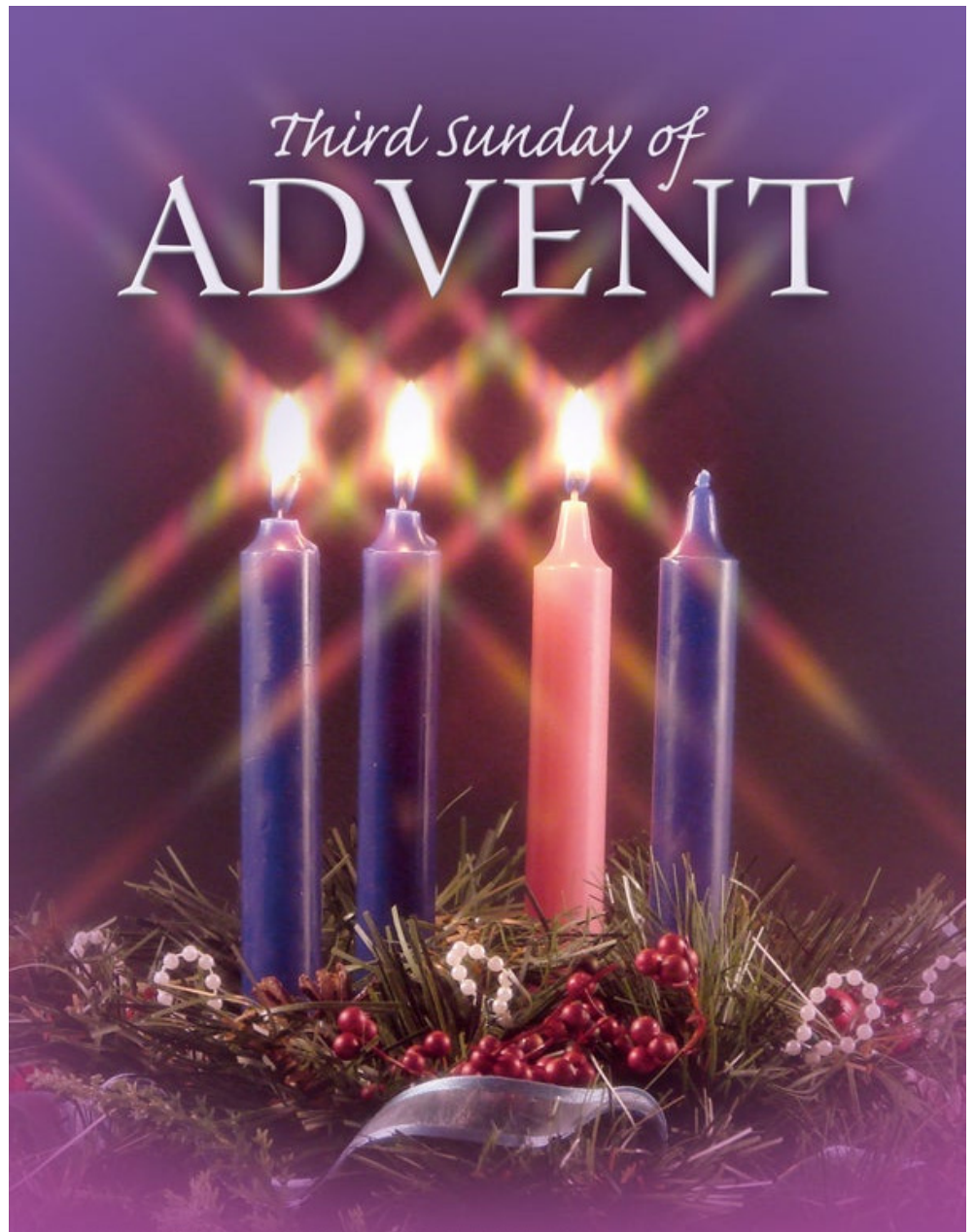

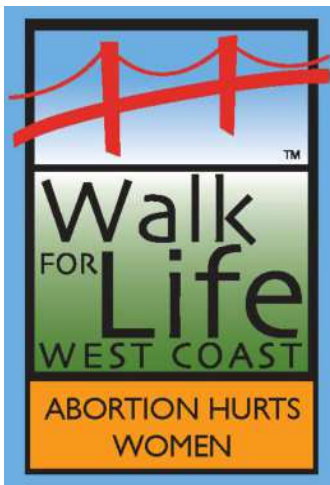

In this Sunday's Gospel, John the Baptist, now in prison, sends his followers to Jesus with this question: "Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?" (Matthew 11:3). Jesus responds by pointing to his healing miracles—healing the blind, curing lepers, raising the dead, and so much more. These are actions the prophet Isaiah foretold would be signs of the Messiah.

John the Baptist prepared the way for Jesus. How can you prepare the way for others to have faith in God's promise?

Note: Your children can help prepare hearts for Christmas by joining our Living Gospel cast! See below how to get involved!

This is the one about whom it is written, 'See, I am sending my messenger ahead of you, who will prepare your way before you.'

MATTHEW 11:10

En el Evangelio de este domingo, Juan el Bautista, ahora en prisión, envía a sus seguidores a Jesús con esta pregunta: «¿Eres tú el que ha de venir, o debemos esperar a otro?» (Mateo 11:3). Jesús responde señalando sus milagros de curación: sanar a los ciegos, curar a los leprosos, resucitar a los muertos y mucho más. Estas son acciones que el profeta Isaías predijo que serían señales del Mesías.

Connecting GOSPEL and DOCTRINE

God sends messages of Joy.

Relación entre el EVANGELIO y la DOCTRINA

God called prophets to share his message with the people of their times and places. They told people that God would never stop loving and forgiving them. They shared that God would send the Messiah to save all people from sin and death. Jesus is the one God promised to send. "Thanks to the prophets Israel understood that it was again out of love that God never stopped saving them and pardoning their unfaithfulness and sins" (CCC, 218).

GAUDETE

Gaudete is Latin for "rejoice," and this day is a break in the penitential mood of Advent, marked by the priest wearing rose vestments and lighting the rose-colored candle on the Advent wreath instead the violet one.

Dios llamó a los profetas para que compartieran su mensaje con la gente de su época y su lugar. Les dijeron a las personas que Dios nunca dejaría de amarlas y perdonarlas. Les comunicaron que Dios enviaría al Mesías para salvar a todas las personas del pecado y la muerte. Jesús es aquel que Dios prometió enviar. «Gracias a los profetas, Israel comprendió que era nuevamente por amor que Dios nunca dejaba de salvarlo y de perdonar su infidelidad y sus pecados» (CIC, 218).

GAUDETE

Gaudete significa «alégrate» en latín, y este día supone una pausa en el ambiente penitencial del Adviento, que se celebra con el sacerdote vistiendo vestimentas rosas y encendiendo la vela rosa de la corona de Adviento en lugar de la violeta.

Summary of the Readings:

Resumen de las lecturas:



- **First Reading** – Isaiah 7:10-14: God told Ahaz to ask for a sign. Ahaz refused, but Isaiah said God would give a sign: a virgin will bear a son named Emmanuel.
- **Responsorial Psalm** – Psalm 24: The Lord owns the earth and all who live in it. Those with pure hearts and clean hands can stand in his holy place and receive his blessings.
- **Second Reading** – Romans 1:1-7: Paul, a servant of Jesus, greets the believers in Rome. He emphasizes Jesus' divine and human natures and wishes them grace and peace.
- **Gospel** – Matthew 1:18-24: Joseph planned to divorce Mary quietly when he found out she was pregnant. An angel told him in a dream to take her as his wife because the child was from the Holy Spirit.

Reflect:

The 4th Sunday of Advent Year A brings us very close to Christmas. The readings help us focus on who Jesus is and why He came. We hear the name Emmanuel, which means "God is with us." This is the message we hold onto as we get ready to celebrate His birth. Each reading gives us something to think about. Isaiah speaks of a sign—a child born to a virgin. Paul reminds the early Christians that Jesus was promised long ago. The psalm talks about who can come into God's presence. And in the Gospel, Joseph listens to God and chooses to stay with Mary. The time is near ... get ready!

- ♦ Think of a someone who made a promise to you and kept it. How did it make you feel? In contrast, think of the promise God makes to us that He will save us from our sins and give us eternal life.
- ♦ How does this promise give you hope? How can you share your hope with others? Pray Psalm 24

- **Primera lectura** – Isaías 7:10-14: Dios le dijo a Acáz que pidiera una señal. Acáz se negó, pero Isaías dijo que Dios daría una señal: una virgen daría a luz un hijo llamado Emmanuel.
- **Salmo responsorial** – Salmo 24: El Señor es dueño de la tierra y de todos los que la habitan. Los que tienen el corazón puro y las manos limpias pueden estar en su lugar santo y recibir sus bendiciones.
- **Segunda lectura** – Romanos 1, 1-7: Pablo, siervo de Jesús, saluda a los creyentes de Roma. Destaca la naturaleza divina y humana de Jesús y les desea gracia y paz.
- **Evangelio** – Mateo 1, 18-24: José planeaba divorciarse discretamente de María cuando se enteró de que estaba embarazada. Un ángel le dijo en un sueño que la tomara por esposa, porque el niño era del Espíritu Santo.

Reflejar:

El cuarto domingo de Adviento del año A nos acerca mucho a la Navidad. Las lecturas nos ayudan a centrarnos en quién es Jesús y por qué vino. Escuchamos el nombre Emmanuel, que significa «Dios está con nosotros». Este es el mensaje al que nos aferramos mientras nos preparamos para celebrar su nacimiento. Cada lectura nos da algo en qué pensar. Isaías habla de una señal: un niño nacido de una virgen. Pablo recuerda a los primeros cristianos que Jesús fue prometido hace mucho tiempo. El salmo habla de quién puede entrar en la presencia de Dios. Y en el Evangelio, José escucha a Dios y decide quedarse con María. El momento se acerca... ¡preparense!

- ♦ Piensa en alguien que te hizo una promesa y la cumplió. ¿Cómo te hizo sentir? En contraste, piensa en la promesa que Dios nos hace de que nos salvará de nuestros pecados y nos dará vida eterna. ¿Cómo te da esperanza esta promesa?
- ♦ ¿Cómo puedes compartir tu esperanza con los demás? Ora el Salmo 24.

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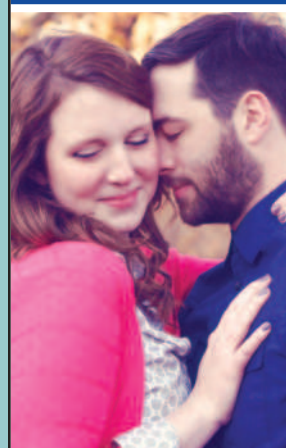
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
