06 • FAITH FORMATION & EVANGELIZATION



The duty of Christians to take part in the life of the Church impels them to act as witnesses of the Gospel and of the obligations that flow from it. This witness is a transmission of the faith in words and deeds. Witness is an act of justice that establishes the truth or makes it known (CCC2472).

This single sentence from the Catechism is powerful. It states that witness is **"an act of justice that establishes the truth or makes it known"** — in your daily life, is there a place where justice is being withheld because the truth of the Gospel is going unspoken?

Relaciondo

EVANGELIO+DOCTRINA

El deber de los cristianos de participar en la vida de la Iglesia les impulsa a actuar como testigos del Evangelio y de las obligaciones que de él se derivan. Esta única frase del Catecismo es poderosa. Afirma que el testimonio es **«un acto de justicia que establece la verdad o la da a conocer»**: en tu vida cotidiana, ¿hay algún lugar donde se esté negando la justicia porque no se está expresando la verdad del Evangelio?



THE SPIRIT MOVES THROUGH THE CHURCH

EL ESPÍRITU SE MUEVE POR TODA LA IGLESIA

The readings for this Sunday tell a single **dynamic story with three movements** reflected in the life of the Church.

First: the Spirit is given. The Apostles heard that Samaria had accepted the word of God, sent Peter and John who prayed for the new believers that the Spirit would come. It is not a private moment but an ecclesial one with apostolic order through which the Apostles move.

Second: the Spirit sends outward. Peter instructs the believers to always be ready to give a defense of their faith with gentleness even at the risk of persuecution. We see the Spirit is not given for one's personal consolation, but for witness.

Lastly: the Spirit transforms from within. Jesus speaks of intimate unity of God, the Spirit and the believer (us); the spirit dwelling personally in the soul of the one who loves and obeys.

Las lecturas de este domingo narran una única **historia dinámica con tres etapas** que se reflejan en la vida de la Iglesia.

Primero: se concede el Espíritu. Los apóstoles, al enterarse de que Samaria había acogido la palabra de Dios, enviaron a Pedro y a Juan, quienes oraron por los nuevos creyentes para que el Espíritu descendiera sobre ellos. No se trata de un momento privado, sino de un acontecimiento eclesial en el que los apóstoles actúan siguiendo el mandato apostólico.

Segundo: el Espíritu envía hacia fuera. Pedro instruye a los creyentes para que estén siempre dispuestos a dar cuenta de su fe con mansedumbre, incluso a riesgo de sufrir persecución. Vemos que el Espíritu no se da para el consuelo personal, sino para dar **testimonio**.

Por último: el Espíritu transforma desde dentro. Jesús habla de la unidad íntima entre Dios, el Espíritu y el creyente (nosotros); el Espíritu que habita personalmente en el alma de quien ama y obedece.

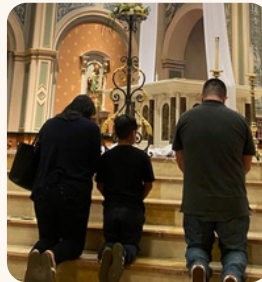

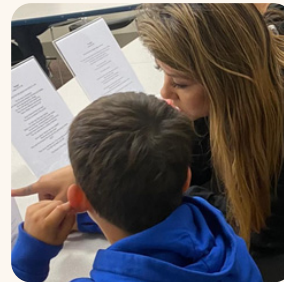

God calls ... we help you respond


Have you felt a quiet pull toward something more – a longing for truth, for belonging, for God? That is not coincidence. That is Christ, inviting you to follow Him.

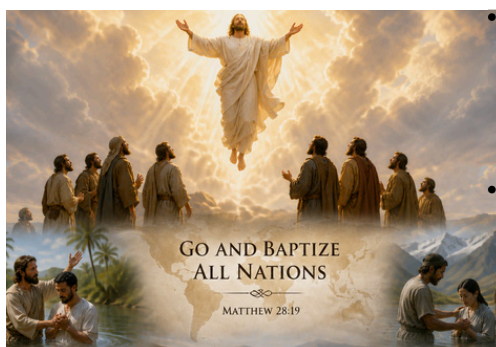
NEXT SUNDAY MASS PREPARATION MAY 17, 2026 – THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

- **First Reading:** [Acts 1:1-11](#) – Luke recounts the events that occurred between Jesus' resurrection and his ascension. Jesus appeared to his disciples, gave them instructions and promises, and was taken up into heaven while they watched.
- **Responsorial Psalm:** [Psalm 47](#) – Response: God mounts his throne to shouts of joy: a blare of trumpets for the Lord.
- **Second Reading:** [Ephesians 1:17-23](#) – A prayer from Paul for the Ephesian believers, asking God to give them spiritual wisdom and knowledge so that they may understand the hope and inheritance they have in Christ. Paul also emphasizes the power of God that was revealed when Christ was raised from the dead and exalted to the highest place, above all earthly powers and authorities.
- **Gospel:** [Matthew 28:16-20](#) – The resurrected Jesus appears to his disciples on a mountain in Galilee. Jesus commissions his disciples to go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything he has commanded.
- **Primera lectura:** Hechos 1, 1-11 – Lucas relata los acontecimientos que tuvieron lugar entre la resurrección de Jesús y su ascensión. Jesús se apareció a sus discípulos, les dio instrucciones y promesas, y fue elevado al cielo ante la mirada de ellos.
- **Salmo responsorial:** Salmo 47 – Respuesta: Dios se sienta en su trono entre gritos de alegría: un estruendo de trompetas para el Señor.
- **Segunda lectura:** Efesios 1, 17-23 – Una oración de Pablo por los creyentes de Éfeso, en la que pide a Dios que les conceda sabiduría y conocimiento espirituales para que puedan comprender la esperanza y la herencia que tienen en Cristo. Pablo también destaca el poder de Dios que se reveló cuando Cristo resucitó de entre los muertos y fue exaltado al lugar más alto, por encima de todos los poderes y autoridades terrenales.
- **Evangelio:** Mateo 28, 16-20 – Jesús resucitado se aparece a sus discípulos en una montaña de Galilea. Jesús encarga a sus discípulos que vayan y hagan discípulos de todas las naciones, bautizándolos en el nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo, y enseñándoles a guardar todo lo que él les ha mandado.

Reflect:

Jesus left so He could be more present to more people. But before leaving, He gave us a Mission, not just a memory, and invites us to work with Him. **He is still with us** through the power of the Holy Spirit, in the Holy Bible, in the Sacraments – especially the most Holy Eucharist, and in the praying community.

- **If Jesus promised to be with us always, where can we find Him this week?**
- **What is one concrete way you and your family can share the faith with someone else this week?**



Reflexión:

Jesús se fue para poder estar más presente entre más personas. Pero antes de marcharse, nos encomendó una misión, no solo un recuerdo, y nos invita a colaborar con Él. Él sigue estando con nosotros a través del poder del Espíritu Santo, en la Sagrada Biblia, en los sacramentos – especialmente en la Santísima Eucaristía– y en la comunidad de oración.

- **Si Jesús prometió estar siempre con nosotros, ¿dónde podemos encontrarlo esta semana?**
- **¿De qué manera concreta pueden tú y tu familia compartir la fe con otra persona esta semana?**

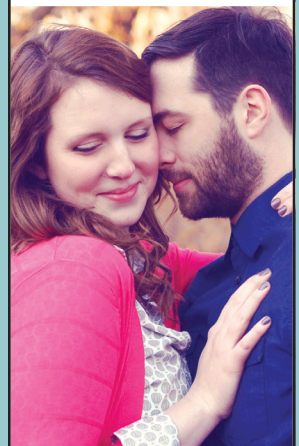

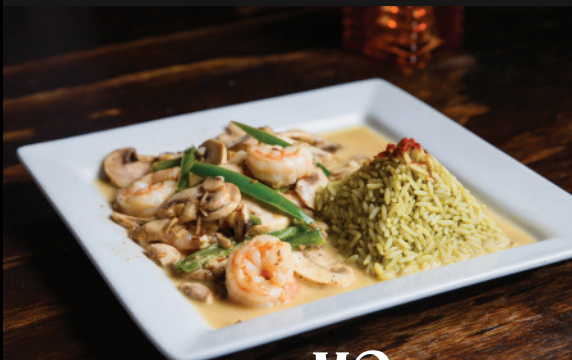

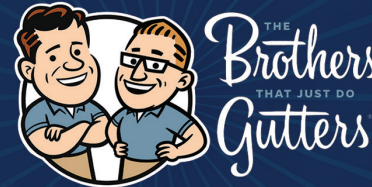
