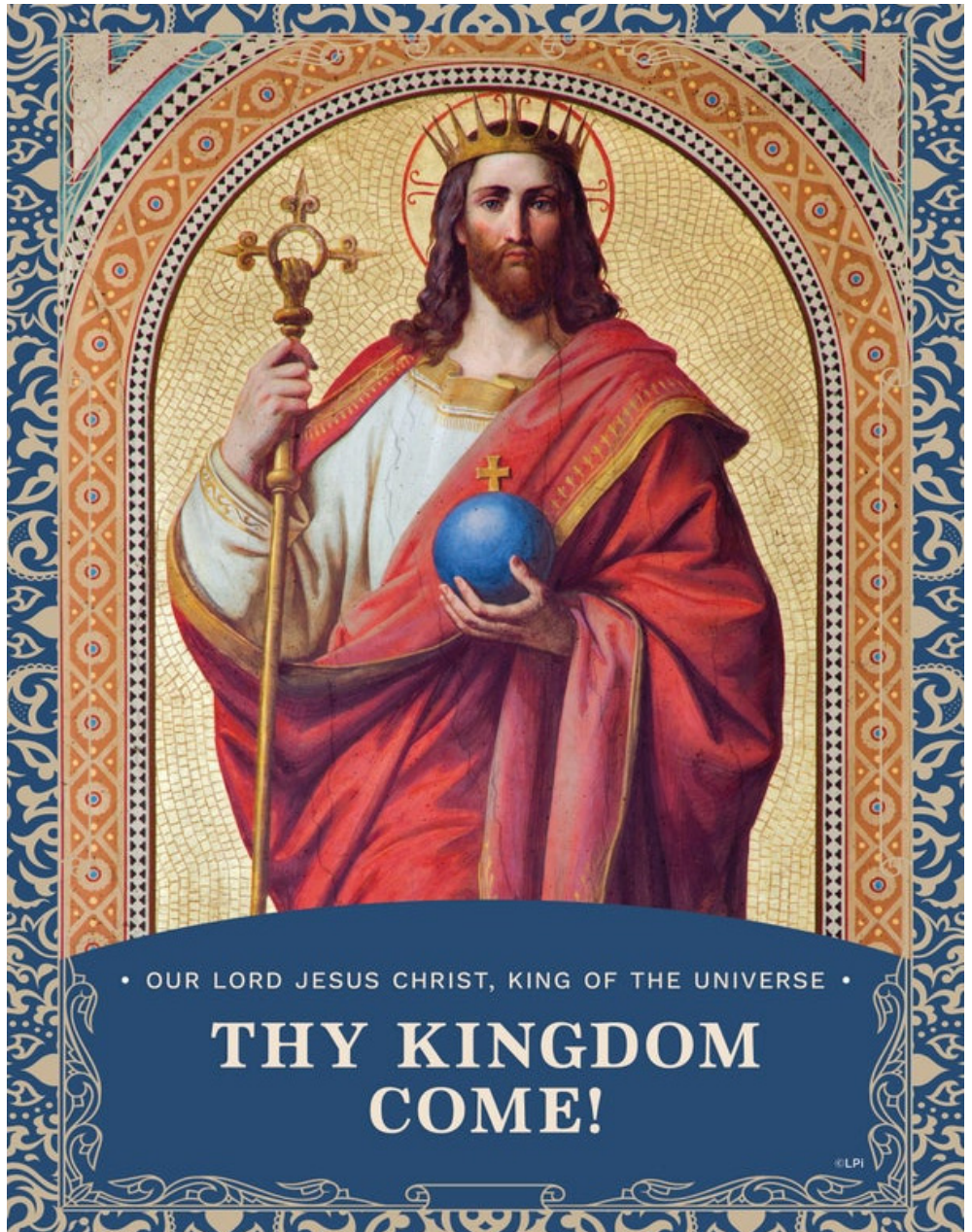

 Pilgrims of Hope

For the Solemnity of Christ the King, the Lectionary chooses a short passage from Luke's account of Jesus' Passion. The Passion depicts Jesus without physical or military power, yet he is dangerous enough to be put to death. As his opponents tease and taunt him, Jesus shows his divine power in forgiving a criminal on a cross near him. This man recognizes his own wrongdoing and truly believes that Jesus can help him get to Heaven. By this action of faith, Jesus transforms the Cross from a place of death to a place of life and forgiveness.



Para la Solemnidad de Cristo Rey, el leccionario utiliza un pasaje corto de la Pasión de Jesús según San Lucas. La Pasión representa a Jesús sin poder físico ni militar; pero aún así es lo suficientemente peligroso como para ser sentenciado a muerte. Mientras sus opositores se burlan y lo retan, Jesús demuestra su poder divino al perdonar al criminal que está junto a él en una cruz. Este hombre reconoce que ha hecho mal y cree que Jesús puede ayudarlo a llegar al cielo. Con este acto, Jesús transforma la cruz de un lugar de muerte a un lugar de vida y perdón.

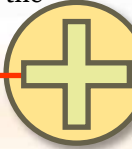

Relación entre el EVANGELIO y la DOCTRINA

"The name 'Christ' comes from the Greek translation of the Hebrew Messiah, which means 'anointed.' [I]n Israel those consecrated to God for a mission that he gave (priest, prophet, king) were anointed in his name. . . . This had to be the case all the more so for the Messiah whom God would send to inaugurate his kingdom" (CCC, 436). "Christ, King and Lord of the universe, made himself the servant of all" (CCC, 786).

«El nombre «Cristo» proviene de la traducción griega del hebreo Mesías, que significa «ungido». En Israel, aquellos consagrados a Dios para una misión que él les había encomendado (sacerdotes, profetas, reyes) eran ungidos en su nombre. [...] Esto tenía que ser así, sobre todo en el caso del Mesías que Dios enviaría para inaugurar su reino» (CIC, 436). «Cristo, Rey y Señor del universo, se hizo siervo de todos» (CIC, 786).

Sunday, November 30, 2025

1st Sunday of Advent
Summary of the Readings:

- **First Reading** – Isaiah 2:1-5: In the future, the Lord's mountain will be the highest. All nations will come to learn His ways, and there will be peace. Let us walk in the light of the Lord.
- **Responsorial Psalm** – Psalm 122: We rejoice as we enter Jerusalem, the unified city of the Lord. We pray for peace and prosperity in Jerusalem, and we give thanks to the Lord's name.
- **Second Reading** – Romans 13:11-14: Wake up, for our salvation is near. Live properly, putting aside darkness and putting on the light of Jesus Christ.
- **Gospel** – Matthew 24:37-44: Jesus warns that His coming will be sudden, like the days of Noah. People will be taken unexpectedly, so stay awake and be ready at all times.

Reflect:

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus foretells the destruction of the Temple. But Jesus is not speaking of a physical structure. Rather, Jesus is foretelling the coming of the Son of Man—that is, the end of the world and his Second Coming. This Scripture offers hope and reassurance. Though Luke anticipates a long delay before Jesus' Second Coming, he makes clear that suffering and persecution are not the end; rather, they anticipate Jesus' return in glory.

- ♦ In the first reading from Isaiah, the call to pray for peace for all nations. How can you be an instrument of peace?
- ♦ Our readings call us to be ready and prepare for the coming of the Lord. What are ways you and your family can make Advent a meaningful time of preparation?
- ♦ Make an Advent Calendar and plan special times for your family to gather and let God lead you this Advent time.
- ♦ Create a "Jesse Tree" ornament each day of Advent beginning December 1st.

1 Domingo de Adviento
Resumen de las lecturas:

- **Primera lectura** – Isaías 2:1-5: En el futuro, la montaña del Señor será la más alta. Todas las naciones vendrán a aprender Sus caminos, y habrá paz. Caminemos en la luz del Señor.
- **Salmo responsorial** – Salmo 122: Nos regocijamos al entrar en Jerusalén, la ciudad unificada del Señor. Oramos por la paz y la prosperidad en Jerusalén, y damos gracias al nombre del Señor.
- **Segunda lectura** – Romanos 13:11-14: Despertad, porque nuestra salvación está cerca. Vivid correctamente, dejando a un lado las tinieblas y vistiendo la luz de Jesucristo.
- **Evangelio** – Mateo 24:37-44: Jesús advierte que su venida será repentina, como en los días de Noé. La gente será llevada inesperadamente, así que permaneced despiertos y estad preparados en todo momento.

Reflejar:

En el Evangelio de este domingo, Jesús predice la destrucción del Templo. Pero Jesús no se refiere a una estructura física. Más bien, Jesús predice la venida del Hijo del Hombre, es decir, el fin del mundo y su Segunda Venida. Esta Escritura ofrece esperanza y tranquilidad. Aunque Lucas anticipa una larga demora antes de la Segunda Venida de Jesús, deja claro que el sufrimiento y la persecución no son el fin, sino que anticipan el regreso de Jesús en gloria.

- ♦ En la primera lectura de Isaías, se nos exhorta a rezar por la paz de todas las naciones. ¿Cómo puedes ser un instrumento de paz?
- ♦ Las lecturas nos invitan a estar preparados para la llegada del Señor. ¿De qué manera tú y tu familia pueden hacer del Adviento un tiempo significativo de preparación?
- ♦ Haz un calendario de Adviento y planifica momentos especiales para que tu familia se reúna y deje que Dios os guíe en este tiempo de Adviento.

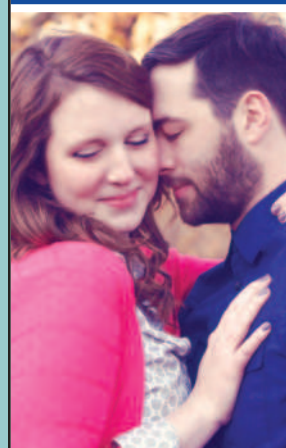
