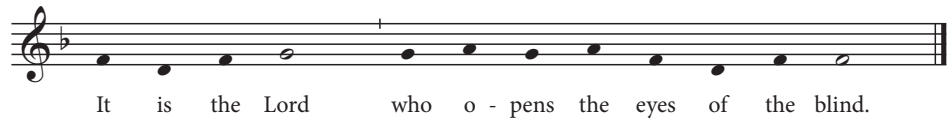

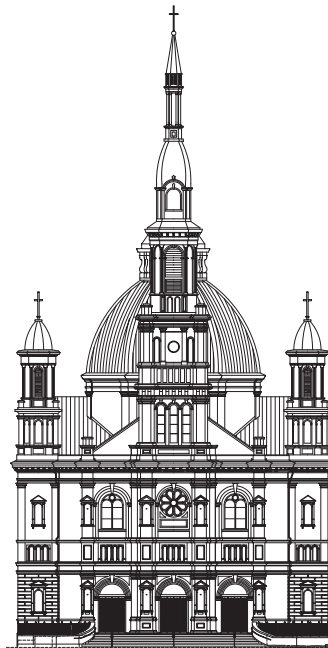

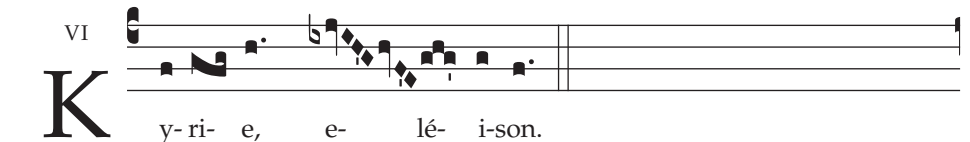
### THE PENITENTIAL ACT

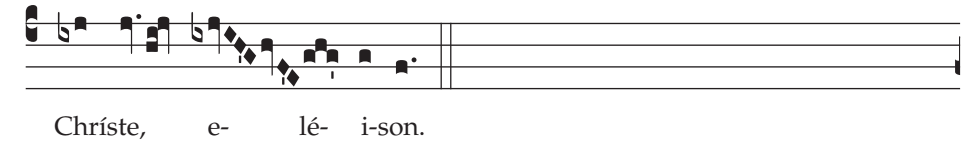

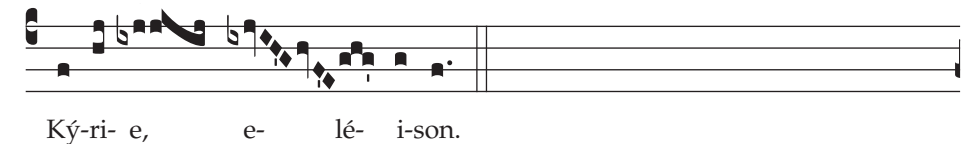
