The Gospel places the beginning of Jesus' ministry in Galilee, where he spent his time teaching, proclaiming God's Kingdom, and healing the sick. Galilee is situated between the Mediterranean Sea and the Sea of Galilee, and many people who lived there were fishermen. Jesus invited his new friends to leave their nets and follow him. He promised them that they would now be fishing for people instead of fish. And they followed Him.

- **How can you share the "good news" of Jesus with others this week?**

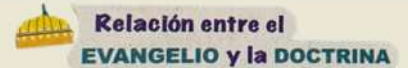


El Evangelio establece el inicio del ministerio de Jesús en Galilea. Allí Jesús pasó su tiempo enseñando, proclamando el Reino de Dios y curando a los enfermos. Galilea está situada entre el mar Mediterráneo y el Mar de Galilea y muchas personas que vivían allí eran pescadores. Jesús invitó a sus nuevos amigos a abandonar sus redes y a seguirlo. ## Jesus Calls us to Follow Him Jesús nos invita a seguirlo



Jesus called twelve men to follow him and be his Apostles. Women and children followed Jesus too. We know about Jesus because others have told us about him. The men who wrote the Gospels tell us about him. As baptized Christians, we must share the Good News of Jesus too. "By his word, through signs that manifest the reign of God, and by sending out his disciples, Jesus calls all people to come together around him" (CCC, 542).

### Apostle

An apostle is **one who is sent** to represent their teacher. Before they were Apostles, the 12 were Disciples—those who follow the teacher and learn from Him. The 12 first named by Jesus: Peter, Andrew, James, John, Philip, Bartholomew (Nathanael), Matthew, Thomas, James son of Alpheus, Judas Thaddaeus, Simon the Zealot and Judas Iscariot, later replaced by Matthias.

Jesús llamó a doce hombres a seguirlo y ser sus apóstoles. Mujeres y niños también seguían a Jesús. Sabemos sobre Jesús porque otras personas nos han hablado de él. Los hombres que escribieron los Evangelios nos hablan de él. Como cristianos bautizados, nosotros también debemos compartir la Buena Nueva de Jesús. "Cristo es el corazón mismo de esta reunión de los hombres como "familia de Dios". Los convoca en torno a él por su palabra, por sus señales que manifiestan el Reino de Dios, por el envío de sus discípulos" (CIC, 542).

### Apóstol

Un apóstol es alguien que es enviado para representar a su maestro. Antes de ser apóstoles, los doce eran discípulos, es decir, aquellos que seguían al maestro y aprendían de él. Los 12 primeros nombrados por Jesús fueron: Pedro, Andrés, Santiago, Juan, Felipe, Bartolomé (Natanael), Mateo, Tomás, Santiago hijo de Alfeo, Judas Tadeo, Simón el Zelote y Judas Iscariote, sustituido más tarde por Matías.

Resumen de las lecturas:



- **First Reading** – Zephaniah 2:3; 3:12-13: The humble who follow God's commands are urged to seek justice and humility for refuge from His wrath. Among them, a peaceful, truthful remnant of Israel will be preserved.
- **Responsorial Psalm** – Psalm 146: The Lord is eternally faithful, upholding justice, feeding the hungry, freeing prisoners, healing, supporting the humble, and ensuring His righteous reign forever.
- **Second Reading** – 1 Corinthians 1:26-31: God chose the unwise, weak, and lowly to confound the mighty, ensuring no one boasts before Him. In Christ, we gain wisdom, righteousness, holiness, and redemption, boasting only in the Lord.
- **Gospel** – Matthew 5:1-12A: On a mountain, Jesus taught his disciples, outlining the Beatitudes. He declared blessings on the spiritually humble, mourners, the gentle, those yearning for righteousness, the merciful, the pure in heart, peacemakers, and those persecuted for righteousness. He encouraged joy amidst persecution for his sake, promising heavenly reward.

## Reflect:

The 4th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A shows us how God sees things differently than we do. The Gospel reading gives us the Beatitudes. Jesus tells us who is truly blessed. It's not the rich or powerful. It's those who are gentle, those who show mercy, and those who suffer for doing what is right. These words are simple, but they show us how to live as followers of Christ. The other readings also remind us to stay humble. If we want to follow Jesus, we must be small in the eyes of the world. That is where God does great things.

- ♦ Read the Beatitudes. How do they challenge the world's thinking about success? How does it challenge yours?
- ♦ How can you practice humility in a world that values self-promotion?
- ♦ Pray Psalm 146

- **Primera lectura** – Sofonías 2:3; 3:12-13: Se exhorta a los humildes que siguen los mandamientos de Dios a buscar la justicia y la humildad como refugio contra su ira. Entre ellos, se preservará un remanente pacífico y veraz de Israel.
- **Salmo responsorial** – Salmo 146: El Señor es eternamente fiel, defiende la justicia, alimenta a los hambrientos, libera a los prisioneros, sana, apoya a los humildes y asegura su reinado justo para siempre.
- **Segunda lectura** – 1 Corintios 1:26-31: Dios eligió a los necios, débiles y humildes para confundir a los poderosos, asegurándose de que nadie se jacte ante Él. En Cristo, obtenemos sabiduría, justicia, santidad y redención, jactándonos solo del Señor.
- **Evangelio** – Mateo 5:1-12A: En una montaña, Jesús enseñó a sus discípulos, esbozando las Bienaventuranzas. Declaró bendiciones para los humildes de espíritu, los que lloran, los mansos, los que anhelan la justicia, los misericordiosos, los puros de corazón, los pacificadores y los perseguidos por la justicia. Animó a la alegría en medio de la persecución por su causa, prometiendo una recompensa celestial.

## Reflejar:

El cuarto domingo del tiempo ordinario del año A nos muestra cómo Dios ve las cosas de manera diferente a nosotros. La lectura del Evangelio nos presenta las Bienaventuranzas. Jesús nos dice quiénes son verdaderamente bienaventurados. No son los ricos ni los poderosos. Son los mansos, los misericordiosos y los que sufren por hacer lo correcto. Estas palabras son sencillas, pero nos muestran cómo vivir como seguidores de Cristo. Las otras lecturas también nos recuerdan que debemos ser humildes. Si queremos seguir a Jesús, debemos ser pequeños a los ojos del mundo. Ahí es donde Dios hace grandes cosas.

- ♦ Lee las Bienaventuranzas. ¿Cómo desafían la forma en que el mundo concibe el éxito? ¿Cómo desafían la tuya?
- ♦ ¿Cómo puedes practicar la humildad en un mundo que valora la autopromoción?
- ♦ Reza el Salmo 146.

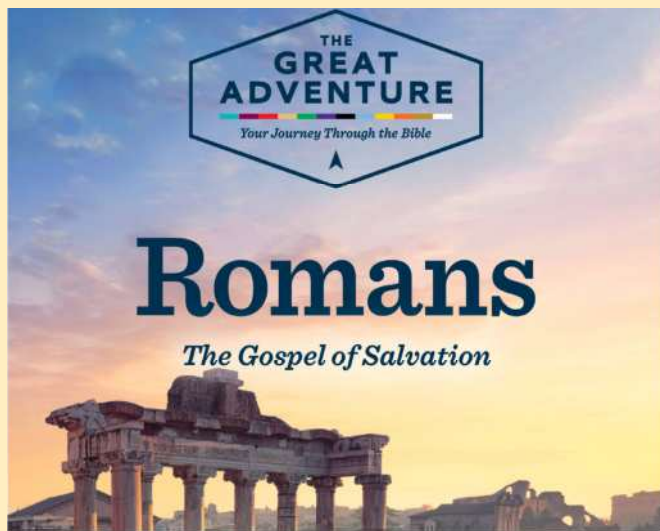

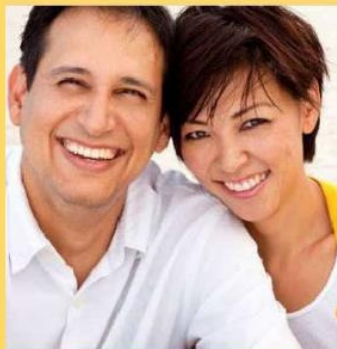

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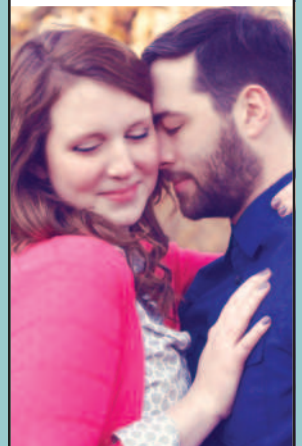
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
