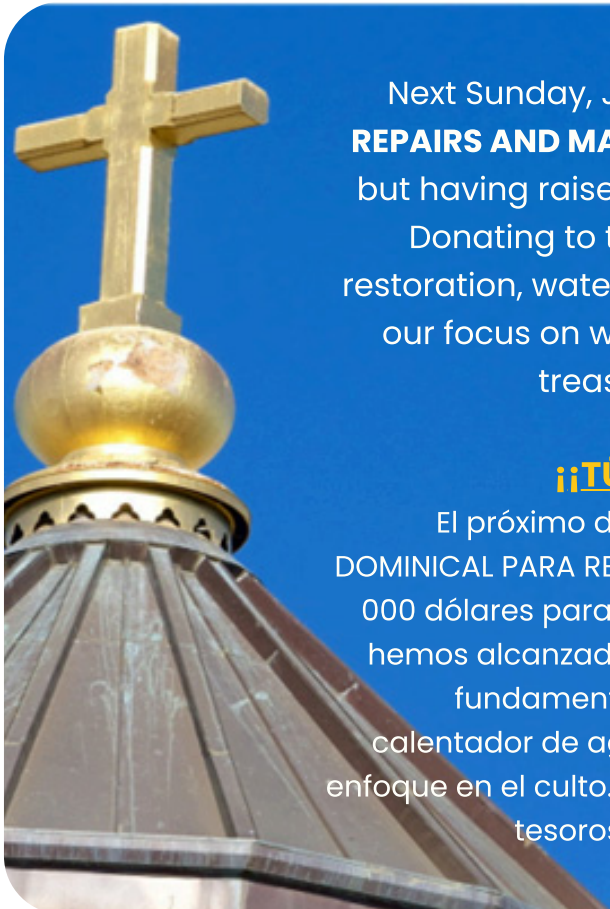
YOU CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE!!

Is AI an inevitable threat to mankind?

What safeguards would be necessary to be in place for humanity to be assured of its benevolent use? Does AI have the real ability to create or evolve into an “Artificial Equivalent” of the human soul, able to think and act on its own volition? The answers to these questions are explored in the film, *The Iron Giant*; the featured film of the upcoming Cinema, Divina Movie Night presentation.

Directing our attention to the teaching of the Catholic Church on the creation of the **human soul**; Paragraphs 365 and 366 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church state; **365** “The unity of soul and body is so profound that one has to consider the soul to be the form of the body: i.e., it is because of its spiritual soul that the body made of matter becomes a living, human body; spirit and matter in man are not two natures united, but rather their union forms a single nature. **366** “The Church teaches that every spiritual soul is created immediately by God –it is not “produced” by the parents–and also that it is immortal: It does not perish when it separates from the body at death, and it will be reunited with the body at the final Resurrection.”

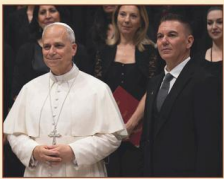

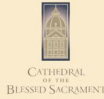

LA SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD | 31 DE MAYO

1st Reading

We hear how God proclaims His name as “Lord” to Moses on Mount Sinai, describing Himself as merciful, gracious, kind, and faithful. How would you describe your experience of God?

2nd Reading

Paul speaks of the grace, love, and fellowship of our triune God and encourages the Corinthians to treat each other likewise. Who needs your love and fellowship this week?

Gospel Reading

Jesus speaks of God’s love and commitment to both people and planet. What do you imagine a “saved” world will look like?

LIVE THE LITURGY

Salvation is a gift God dearly wishes us to accept. It is not a yardstick against which He measures our worth. He has made it so simple. So, will we accept? ©LPI

La salvación es un regalo que Dios desea profundamente que aceptemos. No es un parámetro con el que mida nuestro valor. Él lo ha hecho tan sencillo. Entonces, ¿aceptaremos? ©LPI

St. Paul closes his Second Letter to the Corinthians with a blessing of the three Persons, one God. The Gospel is part of Jesus’s conversation with Nicodemus, and it clearly states that the Father gave His Son Jesus, with infinite love, to bring eternal life. And here is what makes this mystery not just theological, but personal: **the Trinity is not merely a doctrine to be memorized. It is the very shape of love itself.** The Father eternally loves the Son. The Son eternally returns that love. The Holy Spirit is the living bond of that love poured forth. God the Father is “the first origin of everything and transcendent authority” (CCC 239). He “is Father not only in being Creator; He is eternally Father in relation to His only Son, who is eternally Son in relation to His Father” (CCC 240).

Every family — every father, mother, and child — is called to be a faint but real image of that eternal communion. The home is not just a shelter. It is a school of Trinitarian love. Make the Sign of the Cross slowly this week, and think about each Person of the Trinity. That simple gesture — forehead, heart, shoulder to shoulder — traces the whole of salvation across your body.

When you make the Sign of the Cross, what are you actually saying about God?

San Pablo concluye su Segunda Carta a los Corintios con una bendición a las tres Personas, un solo Dios. El Evangelio forma parte de la conversación de Jesús con Nicodemo, y afirma claramente que el Padre entregó a su Hijo Jesús, con amor infinito, para traer la vida eterna. Y esto es lo que hace que este misterio no sea solo teológico, sino personal: **la Trinidad no es meramente una doctrina que hay que memorizar. Es la forma misma del amor.** El Padre ama eternamente al Hijo. El Hijo le devuelve eternamente ese amor. El Espíritu Santo es el vínculo vivo de ese amor derramado. Dios Padre es «el primer origen de todo y la autoridad trascendente» (CIC 239). Él «es Padre no solo por ser Creador; es eternamente Padre en relación con su único Hijo, que es eternamente Hijo en relación con su Padre» (CIC 240).

Cada familia —cada padre, madre e hijo— está llamada a ser una imagen débil pero real de esa comunión eterna. El hogar no es solo un refugio. Es una escuela del amor trinitario. Haz la señal de la cruz lentamente esta semana y piensa en cada Persona de la Trinidad. Ese sencillo gesto —frente, corazón, hombro a hombro— traza toda la salvación a lo largo de tu cuerpo.

Cuando haces la señal de la cruz, ¿qué estás diciendo realmente sobre Dios?

St. Justin Martyr (c. 100 - 165) was a second century apologist. His detailed texts show the depth of the Catholic tradition and were meant to dispel rumors of the early Church practices during the Roman persecution. An eyewitness account of his martyrdom still survives today.

CCC 249 — From the beginning, the revealed truth of the Holy Trinity has been at the very root of the Church's living faith, principally by means of Baptism. It finds its expression in the rule of baptismal faith, formulated in the preaching, catechesis and prayer of the Church. Such formulations are already found in the apostolic writings, such as this salutation taken up in the Eucharistic liturgy: 'The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.'

Family connection: The very blessing that closes St. Paul's letter — and was quoted in the reflection — is itself a Trinitarian formula that the Church has prayed from the very beginning.

Relaciondo EVANGELIO+DOCTRINA

CCC 249 — Desde el principio, la verdad revelada de la Santísima Trinidad ha estado en la raíz misma de la fe viva de la Iglesia, principalmente a través del Bautismo. Encuentra su expresión en la regla de la fe bautismal, formulada en la predicación, la catequesis y la oración de la Iglesia. Tales formulaciones ya se encuentran en los escritos apostólicos, como este saludo recogido en la liturgia eucarística: «La gracia del Señor Jesucristo, el amor de Dios y la comunión del Espíritu Santo estén con todos vosotros».

Conexión familiar: La misma bendición con la que concluye la carta de san Pablo —y que se ha citado en la reflexión— es en sí misma una fórmula trinitaria que la Iglesia ha rezado desde el principio.

PREPARACIÓN PARA LA MISA DEL PRÓXIMO DOMINGO • 09

NEXT SUNDAY MASS PREPARATION JUNE 7, 2026 – THE SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI

- **First Reading** – Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14B-16A: God led and tested the Israelites in the desert, providing manna and water, to show that life depends on His word.
- **Responsorial Psalm** – Psalm 147: Praise the Lord for strengthening Jerusalem, granting peace, and sharing his word and laws with Israel.
- **Second Reading** – 1 Corinthians 10:16-17: The cup and bread we bless signify our sharing in Christ's blood and body, uniting us as one body.
- **Gospel** – John 6:51-58: Jesus declares He is the living bread from heaven. To have eternal life, we must eat His flesh and drink His blood, ensuring our union with Him and eternal life.
- **Primera lectura** – Deuteronomio 8, 2-3. 14b-16a: Dios guió y puso a prueba a los israelitas en el desierto, proporcionándoles maná y agua, para demostrar que la vida depende de su palabra.
- **Salmo responsorial** – Salmo 147: Alabado sea el Señor por fortalecer a Jerusalén, conceder la paz y compartir su palabra y sus leyes con Israel.
- **Segunda lectura** – 1 Corintios 10, 16-17: La copa y el pan que bendecimos simbolizan nuestra participación en la sangre y el cuerpo de Cristo, uniéndonos como un solo cuerpo.
- **Evangelio** – Juan 6, 51-58: Jesús declara que Él es el pan vivo que viene del cielo. Para tener vida eterna, debemos comer su carne y beber su sangre, asegurando así nuestra unión con Él y la vida eterna.

Reflect:

All of next Sunday's readings are about meals: Abram's victory meal, the Last Supper, and the Feeding of the Five Thousand. That is not accidental. **God** is making a point – repeated three times – that He **feeds His people**. God uses food to remind us that we hunger for Him. And this is the beating heart of Corpus Christi: every hunger the human person feels - for belonging, for meaning, for love, for permanence - finds its only true answer in the Eucharist - the Living Bread.

Act:

Just as Jesus has become our REAL food, giving Himself, so we too must give ourselves for the sake of others.

How are you going to care for another's needs this week, to help them see Christ is feeding them through you?

Reflexión:

Todas las lecturas del próximo domingo tratan sobre comidas: la comida de celebración de Abram, la Última Cena y el milagro de la multiplicación de los panes y los peces. No es casualidad. **Dios** quiere dejarnos claro –y lo repite tres veces– que Él **alimenta a su pueblo**. Dios utiliza la comida para recordarnos que tenemos hambre de Él.
