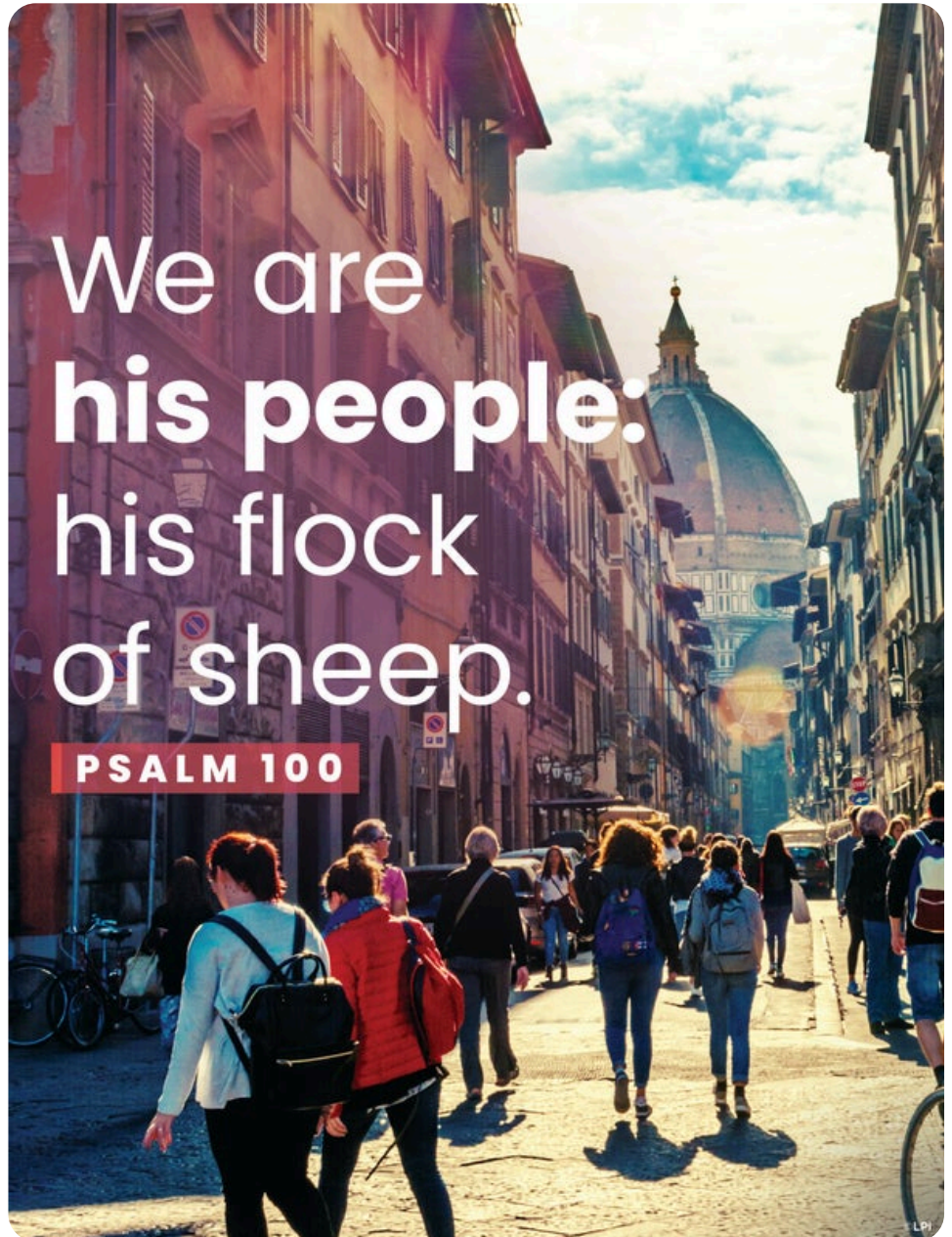

**Is AI an inevitable threat to mankind?** What safeguards would be necessary to be in place for humanity to be assured of its benevolent use? Does AI have the real ability to create or evolve into an “Artificial Equivalent” of the **human soul**, able to think and act on its own volition? The answers to these questions are explored in the film, *The Iron Giant*; the featured film of the upcoming Cinema, Divina Movie Night presentation.

Directing our attention to the teaching of the Catholic Church on the creation of the human soul; Paragraphs 365 and 366 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church state; **365** “The unity of soul and body is so profound that one has to consider the soul to be the form of the body: i.e., it is because of its spiritual soul that the body made of matter becomes a living, human body; spirit and matter in man are not two natures united, but rather their union forms a single nature. **366** “The Church teaches that every spiritual soul is created immediately by God –it is not “produced” by the parents– and also that it is immortal: It does not perish when it separates from the body at death, and it will be reunited with the body at the final Resurrection.”

## WE ARE CHOSEN TO LOVE | JUNE 14, 2026

## HEMOS SIDO ELEGIDOS PARA AMAR

- **First Reading** – Exodus 19:2-6a: The Israelites arrive at Mount Sinai, where God speaks to Moses and tells him to convey a message to the people. God reminds the Israelites of how He delivered them from slavery in Egypt and declares that if they obey His commands and keep His covenant, they will be a treasured possession and a kingdom of priests.
- **Responsorial Psalm** – Psalm 100: This passage is a call to all people to praise and serve the Lord joyfully, recognizing that we are His people and the sheep of His flock.
- **Second Reading** – Romans 5:6-11: God showed His love for humanity by sending Jesus Christ to die for our sins while we were still sinners.
- **Gospel** – Matthew 9:36-10:8: Jesus has compassion for the crowds. He decides to send out His twelve disciples to heal the sick, raise the dead, and proclaim the good news of the kingdom of heaven. Jesus instructs His disciples to freely give what they have received, encouraging them to serve others with love and generosity.



- **Primera lectura** – Éxodo 19, 2-6a: Los israelitas llegan al monte Sinaí, donde Dios habla a Moisés y le pide que transmita un mensaje al pueblo. Dios recuerda a los israelitas cómo los liberó de la esclavitud en Egipto y les anuncia que, si obedecen sus mandamientos y guardan su alianza, serán un pueblo preciado y un reino de sacerdotes.
- **Salmo responsorial** – Salmo 100: Este pasaje es una llamada a todo el pueblo a alabar y servir al Señor con alegría, reconociendo que somos su pueblo y las ovejas de su rebaño.
- **Segunda lectura** – Romanos 5, 6-11: Dios mostró su amor por la humanidad enviando a Jesucristo a morir por nuestros pecados cuando aún éramos pecadores.
- **Evangelio** – Mateo 9, 36-10, 8: Jesús tiene compasión de las multitudes. Decide enviar a sus doce discípulos a curar a los enfermos, resucitar a los muertos y proclamar la buena nueva del reino de los cielos. Jesús instruye a sus discípulos para que den gratuitamente lo que han recibido, animándolos a servir a los demás con amor y generosidad.

Divine election always begins with a look from God; not with human ambition or worthiness, but with the **gaze of a God who sees His people** as sheep without a shepherd and refuses to leave them that way. Out of that compassionate gaze, Jesus does something stunning. He doesn't recruit volunteers. He doesn't post a notice in the synagogue. **He chooses.** He names twelve specific men — flawed, ordinary, often confused — and grants them a share in His own authority. And so God does what God always does: **He elects the unlikely and equips them for the impossible.** This is the pattern written across all of salvation history. He chose Abraham from among the nations. He chose David from the back fields of Bethlehem. He chose a teenage girl from Nazareth to carry the Son of God. And in Baptism, He chose you. Divine election is not a cold theological abstraction — it is the most personal truth in the universe. Your name was known before the foundation of the world. The same Lord who called Matthew away from his tax collector's booth and Peter away from his nets has looked out at this congregation — at this moment in history — and said: the harvest is plentiful, and I need you. The mission is not reserved for priests and religious. **Every baptized Catholic has been chosen, named, and sent. The only question left is whether we will go?**

La elección divina siempre comienza con una mirada de Dios: no con la ambición o la dignidad humanas, sino con **la mirada de un Dios que ve a su pueblo** como ovejas sin pastor y se niega a dejarlas así. A partir de esa mirada compasiva, Jesús hace algo asombroso. No recluta voluntarios. No cuelga un anuncio en la sinagoga. **Él elige.** Nombra a doce hombres concretos —imperfectos, corrientes, a menudo confundidos— y les concede una parte de su propia autoridad. Y así, Dios hace lo que siempre hace: **elige a los más improbables y los equipa para lo imposible.** Este es el patrón que se repite a lo largo de toda la historia de la salvación. Eligió a Abraham de entre las naciones. Eligió a David de los campos de Belén. Eligió a una adolescente de Nazaret para que llevara en su vientre al Hijo de Dios. Y en el bautismo, te eligió a ti. La elección divina no es una fría abstracción teológica: es la verdad más personal del universo. Tu nombre era conocido antes de la fundación del mundo. El mismo Señor que llamó a Mateo para que dejara su puesto de recaudador de impuestos y a Pedro para que dejara sus redes ha mirado a esta congregación —en este momento de la historia — y ha dicho: la mies es abundante, y os necesito. La misión no está reservada a los sacerdotes y religiosos. **Todo católico bautizado ha sido elegido, nombrado y enviado. La única pregunta que queda es: ¿iremos?**

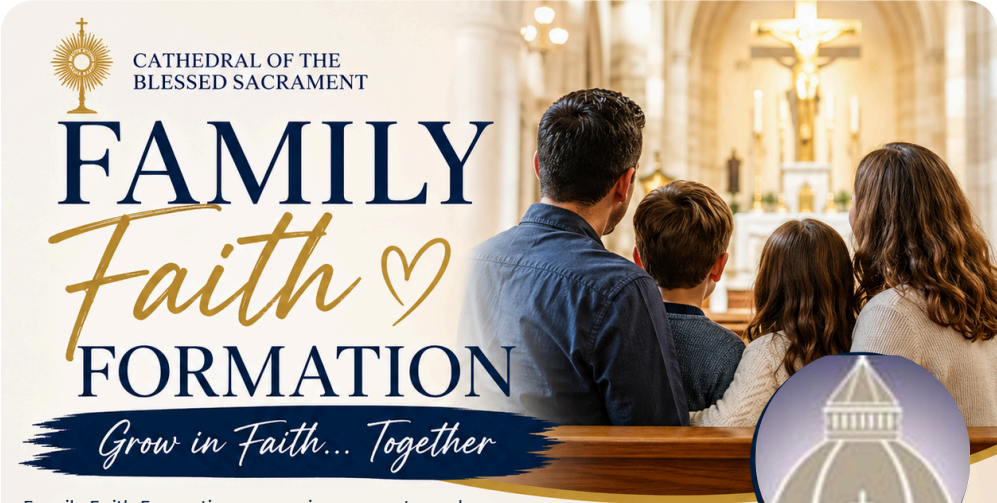

The pattern of **divine election** runs through the entire sweep of Scripture. God chose Abraham from among all the nations. He chose David — the youngest, least likely son of Jesse — to be king. He chose Mary, a young girl from Nazareth, to carry the eternal Son of God. In each case, the choosing is entirely God's initiative, not human merit. This is the logic of grace: **God elects not because of what we have done, but because of who He is.** God's divine election is held in respect of genuine human freedom — both affirmed, neither dissolved into the other. It refuses fatalism on one side and Pelagianism (salvation by human effort) on the other.

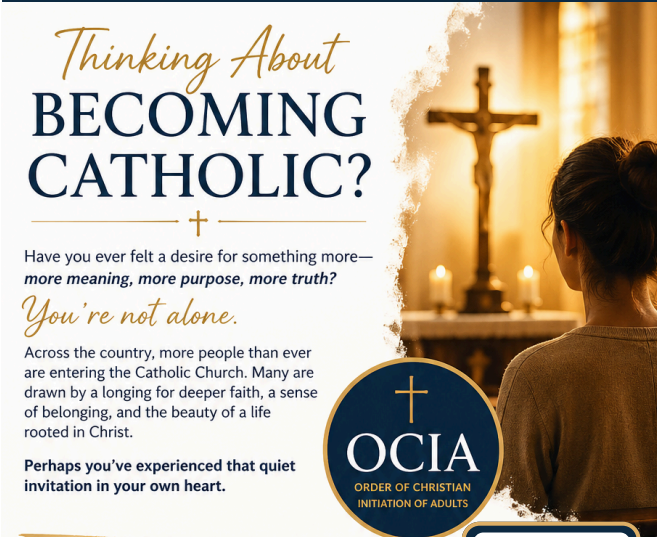
💡 **Family connection:** At Baptism each of us are called by name. That before you could do anything to earn it, He chose you!

## Relaciondo

### EVANGELIO+DOCTRINA

El patrón de la elección divina recorre toda la Escritura. Dios eligió a Abraham de entre todas las naciones. Eligió a David —el hijo más joven y menos probable de Isaí— para ser rey. Eligió a María, una joven de Nazaret, para que llevara en su seno al Hijo eterno de Dios. En cada caso, la elección es enteramente iniciativa de Dios, no mérito humano. Esta es la lógica de la gracia: **Dios elige no por lo que hemos hecho, sino por quién es Él.** La elección divina de Dios se mantiene en respeto a la auténtica libertad humana: ambas se afirman, ninguna se disuelve en la otra. Rechaza el fatalismo por un lado y el pelagianismo (la salvación por el esfuerzo humano) por el otro.

💡 **Conexión familiar:** En el bautismo, a cada uno de nosotros se nos llama por nuestro nombre. ¡Antes de que pudieras hacer nada para ganártelo, Él te eligió!

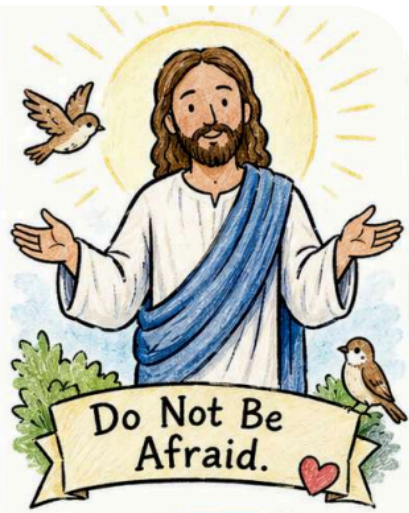

## NEXT SUNDAY MASS PREPARATION JUNE 21, 2026 – 12TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### MAIN MESSAGE

- God is with us in times of fear.
- Do not be afraid—God cares for you.
- Grace through Jesus is stronger than sin.
- Stand up for Jesus—He will stand up for you.



### THE READINGS

**First Reading**  
Jeremiah 20:10-13  
God is with Jeremiah and will save him.

**Psalm**  
Psalm 69  
God hears the poor and shows mercy.

**Second Reading**  
Romans 5:12-15  
Sin came through Adam, but grace comes through Jesus.

**Gospel**  
Matthew 10:26-33  
Do not be afraid. God knows and cares for you.

### WHAT THIS MEANS FOR US

- Evangelio: Mateo 10, 26-33. No tengáis miedo. Dios os conoce y cuida de vosotros.

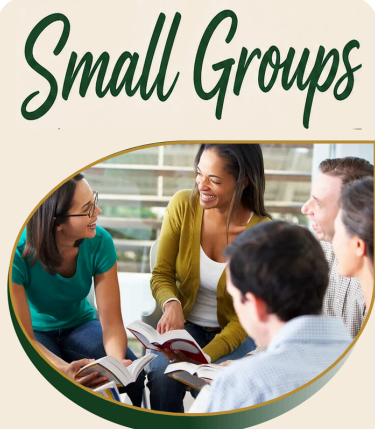
### Preguntas para la reflexión:

2. ¿Cómo me demuestra Dios que se preocupa por mí?
3. ¿Qué me ayuda a confiar más en Dios cada día?

Act:  
**All of us know what it feels like to be afraid and are frozen from doing what we know is right and pleasing to God. This is the challenge in becoming disciples.**  
Think about a situation you are afraid to act in because you are afraid of what others will think. Write a prayer asking God to help you overcome your fear and have moral courage to do the good anyway.

Acción:  
**Todos sabemos lo que se siente al tener miedo y quedamos paralizados, incapaces de hacer lo que sabemos que es correcto y que agrada a Dios. Este es el reto de ser discípulos.**

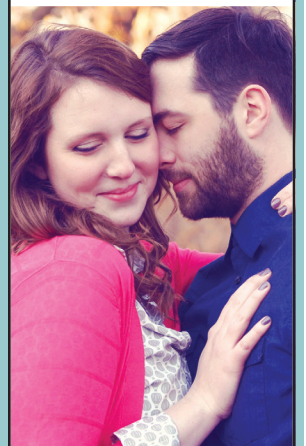

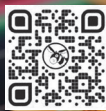

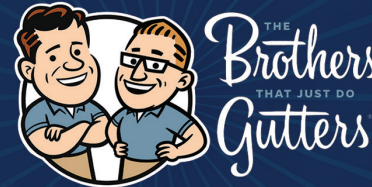
