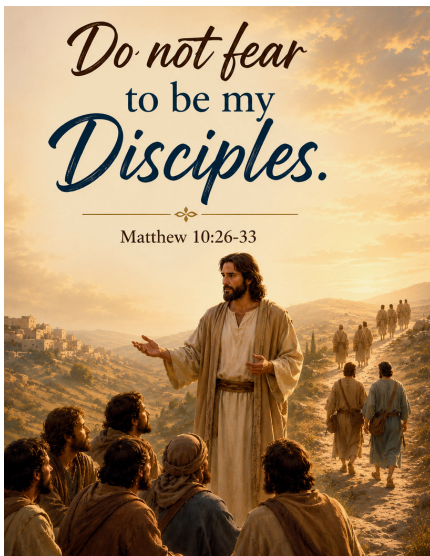

WE ARE CHOSEN TO LOVE | JUNE 21, 2026

HEMOS SIDO ELEGIDOS PARA AMAR

- **First Reading** – Jeremiah 20:10-13: Jeremiah feels frustrated and afraid because people are against him for speaking God's message. But he trusts that God is with him, protecting and strengthening him. He believes God will save him from his enemies.
- **Responsorial Psalm** – Psalms 69: Call on God with faith, and He will answer with love. Even when others insult or reject you, trust in His mercy. God listens to the poor and those who suffer. Let all creation praise Him.
- **Second Reading** – Romans 5:12-15: Sin and death came into the world through Adam. But Jesus Christ brings grace and eternal life. Adam's sin brought punishment, but Jesus' sacrifice brings forgiveness and new life to those who believe in Him.
- **Gospel** – Matthew 10:26-33: Jesus tells His followers not to be afraid to share His message. Everything will be made known in time. Do not fear people who can only harm the body—fear God, who has power over both body and soul. If you stand up for Jesus, He will stand up for you before God.



- **Primera lectura** – Jeremías 20, 10-13: Jeremías se siente frustrado y temeroso porque la gente se opone a él por proclamar el mensaje de Dios. Pero confía en que Dios está con él, protegiéndole y fortaleciéndole. Cree que Dios le salvará de sus enemigos.
- **Salmo responsorial** – Salmo 69: Invoca a Dios con fe, y Él te responderá con amor. Incluso cuando otros te insulten o te rechacen, confía en su misericordia. Dios escucha a los pobres y a los que sufren. Que toda la creación le alabe.
- **Segunda lectura** – Romanos 5, 12-15: El pecado y la muerte entraron en el mundo a través de Adán. Pero Jesucristo trae la gracia y la vida eterna. El pecado de Adán trajo el castigo, pero el sacrificio de Jesús trae el perdón y una nueva vida a quienes creen en Él.
- **Evangelio** – Mateo 10, 26-33: Jesús dice a sus seguidores que no teman compartir su mensaje. Todo se revelará a su debido tiempo. No temáis a quienes solo pueden hacer daño al cuerpo; temed a Dios, que tiene poder sobre el cuerpo y el alma. Si defendéis a Jesús, Él os defenderá ante Dios.

This Sunday, Jesus speaks directly into the fears of every heart: **"Do not be afraid."** In the Gospel of Matthew, He reminds His disciples — and every Catholic family reading these words right now — that God's watchful love extends even to the sparrow that falls to the ground. How much more, then, does He hold each of us? Jeremiah faced ridicule and hostility for speaking God's truth, yet he stood firm because he trusted that the Lord was with him. Paul reminds us in Romans that no matter how deep the wound of sin runs, God's grace runs deeper still. Christ is calling each of us — young and old, cradle Catholic and newly received — to acknowledge Him boldly before the world. Not from a place of arrogance, but from a place of unshakeable trust. **To be a disciple – good Steward – is not a call to comfort; it is a call to courage.** This week, let the words of Jesus be your anchor. He knows your name, He counts every hair on your head, and He is asking you — do not be afraid to be His disciple.

Challenge this Week:

The Psalm this week challenges us to "Call on God with faith and He will answer with love." Think about a situation you are afraid to act in because you have fear for what others will think. Write a prayer asking God to help you overcome your fear, to stand with Jesus, and have moral courage to do the good anyway.

Este domingo, Jesús se dirige directamente a los temores de cada corazón: «No temáis». En el Evangelio de Mateo, recuerda a sus discípulos —y a todas las familias católicas que lean estas palabras en este momento— que el amor vigilante de Dios se extiende incluso al gorrion que cae al suelo. ¿Cuánto más, pues, nos sostiene a cada uno de nosotros? Jeremías se enfrentó al ridículo y a la hostilidad por proclamar la verdad de Dios, pero se mantuvo firme porque confiaba en que el Señor estaba con él. Pablo nos recuerda en Romanos que, por muy profunda que sea la herida del pecado, la gracia de Dios es aún más profunda. Cristo nos llama a cada uno de nosotros —jóvenes y mayores, católicos de cuna y recién bautizados— a reconocerlo con valentía ante el mundo. No desde la arrogancia, sino desde una confianza inquebrantable. Ser discípulo —buen administrador— no es una llamada a la comodidad; es una llamada al valor. Esta semana, deja que las palabras de Jesús sean tu ancla. Él conoce tu nombre, cuenta cada cabello de tu cabeza y te pide: no temas ser su discípulo.

Reto de esta semana:

El salmo de esta semana nos anima a «invocar a Dios con fe y Él te responderá con amor». Piensa en una situación en la que te da miedo actuar porque temes lo que pensarán los demás. Escribe una oración pidiendo a Dios que te ayude a superar tu miedo, a permanecer junto a Jesús y a tener el valor moral para hacer el bien de todos modos.

The Catechism gives this Sunday's call a name: fortitude. Fortitude is the moral virtue that ensures firmness in difficulties and constancy in the pursuit of the good. It strengthens the resolve to resist temptations and overcome obstacles in the moral life (CCC 1808). In the Gospel, Jesus isn't asking His disciples to be fearless – but faith-filled with courage. St Thomas Aquinas teaches us: courage is not the absence of fear – it is the ability to overcome fear. It is the strength of character to persevere in doing right despite being afraid. We are called not to follow Christ because we fear punishment; we follow out of love for the one who “first loved us” (CCC 1828).

 **Family connection:** At Confirmation we are sealed with Christ's Spirit. How will you live out your Discipleship today with confidence of your calling?

El Catecismo pone nombre a la llamada de este domingo: la fortaleza. La fortaleza es la virtud moral que garantiza la firmeza ante las dificultades y la constancia en la búsqueda del bien. Fortalece la determinación de resistir a las tentaciones y superar los obstáculos en la vida moral (CIC 1808). En el Evangelio, Jesús no pide a sus discípulos que sean intrépidos, sino que estén llenos de fe y de valor. Santo Tomás de Aquino nos enseña: el valor no es la ausencia de miedo, sino la capacidad de vencerlo. Es la fuerza de carácter para perseverar en hacer el bien a pesar del miedo. No estamos llamados a seguir a Cristo porque temamos el castigo; lo seguimos por amor a aquel que «nos amó primero» (CIC 1828).

 **Conexión familiar:** En la Confirmación somos sellados con el Espíritu de Cristo. ¿Cómo vas a vivir hoy tu discipulado con la confianza de tu vocación?

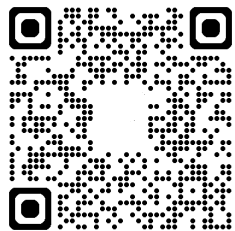

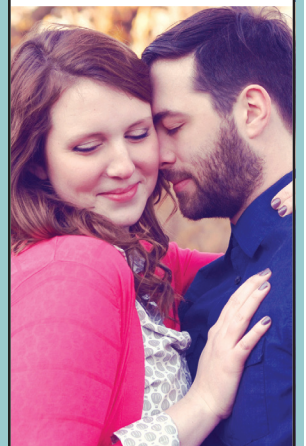

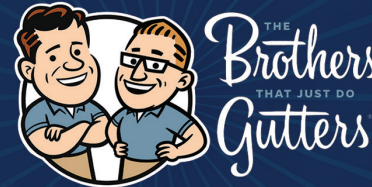
