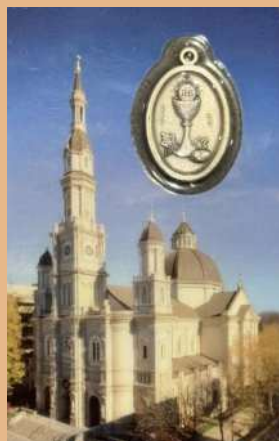

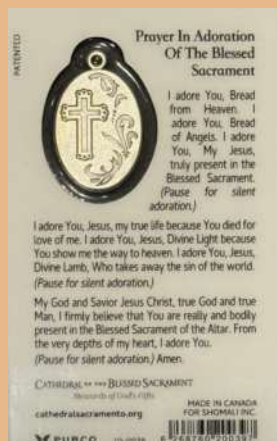

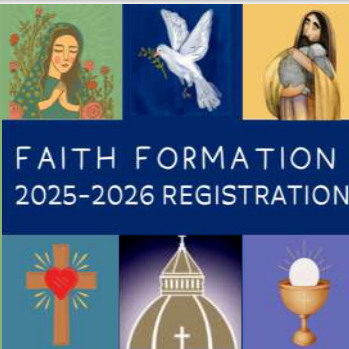

Introduction for Families

1 Liturgical Catechesis

This is a method of instruction integrating faith formation lessons with the life of the parish community experienced in the Sunday Eucharist. The content of the program flows from the Sunday Gospel and children learn their faith within the rhythms of the liturgical year – Advent, Christmas, Lent, Easter and Ordinary Time.

2 Sunday Mass

The Sunday liturgy is the heart of the Cathedral parish community. The weekly celebration becomes more meaningful to young people because they are familiar with the Gospel proclaimed each week. By studying it in class and wrestling with its meaning at home, Family Faith Formation prepares students and families to hear the Gospel of Jesus Christ. They learn to love the Gospel, which helps them to live the Gospel in their daily lives, becoming witnesses in loving service to their peers and every person they meet.

Formación en la Fe y Evangelización

Mass Preparation
Sunday, September 7, 2025

**Prepare: 23rd Sunday
in Ordinary Time**



Summary of the Readings:

- **First Reading** – Wisdom 9:13-18B: Understanding God's intentions is beyond human capacity without divine wisdom and the Holy Spirit, as earthly concerns often cloud our judgment.
- **Responsorial Psalm** – Psalm 90: God, timeless and eternal, teaches us to value our days and seeks our return to righteousness, offering mercy and favor throughout our fleeting lives.
- **Second Reading** – Philemon 9-10, 12-17: Paul, imprisoned, sends Onesimus back to Philemon, not as a slave but as a beloved brother, urging Philemon to welcome him as he would Paul himself.
- **Gospel** – Luke 14:25-33: Jesus teaches that following him requires prioritizing him above all personal relationships and possessions, emphasizing the need to consider the sacrifices involved, much like planning a construction or a battle.

Next Sunday's readings teach us that we must be willing to count the cost of what following Jesus means. Can we let go of things in our life that keep us from growing in our faith? Are we ready to accept the difficult moments (crosses) in our lives and trust in God? It is not enough to say "we believe" in Jesus; we must be willing to show our faith with our actions.

Reflect:

- ♦ Take inventory of your possessions. Which ones get in your way from putting God first in your life?
- ♦ How does putting Jesus first affect your relationships with family and friends?
- ♦ How can you show others that they are loved as part of God's family?
- ♦ Pray with Psalm 90.

**Prepara: XXIII Domingo
del Tiempo Ordinario**

Resumen de las lecturas:

- **Primera lectura** – Sabiduría 9:13-18B: Comprender las intenciones de Dios está más allá de la capacidad humana sin la sabiduría divina y el Espíritu Santo, ya que las preocupaciones terrenales a menudo nublan nuestro juicio.
- **Salmo responsorial** – Salmo 90: Dios, eterno e intemporal, nos enseña a valorar nuestros días y busca nuestro retorno a la rectitud, ofreciéndonos misericordia y favor a lo largo de nuestras fugaces vidas.
- **Segunda lectura** – Filemón 9-10, 12-17: Pablo, encarcelado, envía a Onésimo de vuelta a Filemón, no como esclavo, sino como hermano querido, instando a Filemón a que lo acoja como lo haría con el propio Pablo.
- **Evangelio** – Lucas 14:25-33: Jesús enseña que seguirlo requiere darle prioridad por encima de todas las relaciones personales y posesiones, enfatizando la necesidad de considerar los sacrificios que ello implica, al igual que se planifica una construcción o una batalla.

Las lecturas del próximo domingo nos enseñan que debemos estar dispuestos a calcular el costo de lo que significa seguir a Jesús. ¿Podemos desprendernos de las cosas de nuestra vida que nos impiden crecer en la fe? ¿Estamos dispuestos a aceptar los momentos difíciles (cruces) de nuestra vida y a confiar en Dios? No basta con decir «creemos» en Jesús; debemos estar dispuestos a demostrar nuestra fe con nuestras acciones.

Reflejar:

- ♦ Haz un inventario de tus posesiones. ¿Cuáles te impiden poner a Dios en primer lugar en tu vida?
- ♦ ¿Cómo afecta el poner a Jesús en primer lugar a tus relaciones con tu familia y amigos?
- ♦ ¿Cómo puedes mostrar a los demás que son amados como parte de la familia de Dios?
- ♦ Ora con el Salmo 90.

On a sabbath Jesus went to dine at the home of one of the leading Pharisees, and the people there were observing him carefully.

He told a parable to those who had been invited, noticing how they were choosing the places of honor at the table.

“When you are invited by someone to a wedding banquet, do not recline at table in the place of honor. A more distinguished guest than you may have been invited by him, and the host who invited both of you may approach you and say, ‘Give your place to this man,’ and then you would proceed with embarrassment to take the lowest place. Rather, when you are invited, go and take the lowest place so that when the host comes to you he may say, ‘My friend, move up to a higher position.’ Then you will enjoy the esteem of your companions at the table. For every one who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted.” Then he said to the host who invited him, “When you hold a lunch or a dinner, do not invite your friends or your brothers or your relatives or your wealthy neighbors, in case they may invite you back and you have repayment. Rather, when you hold a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind; blessed indeed will you be because of their inability to repay you. For you will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous.

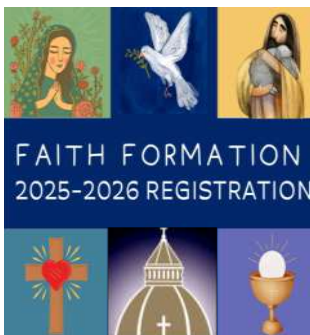

EVANGELIO LC 14, 1. 7-14

Un sábado, Jesús fue a comer en casa de uno de los jefes de los fariseos, y éstos estaban espiándolo. Mirando cómo los convidados escogían los primeros lugares, les dijo esta parábola:
