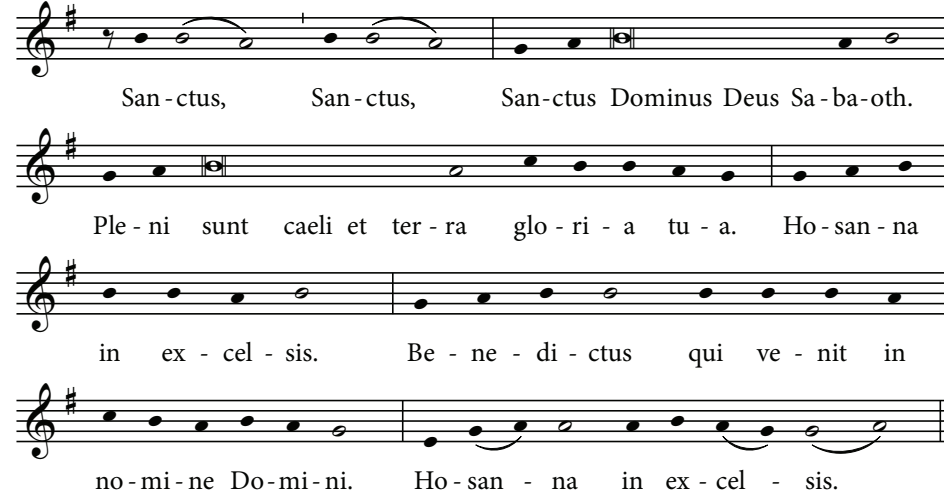
*Nolo mortem peccatoris; haec sunt verba Salvatoris.

but suffered all, and all for this: *Nolo mortem peccatoris.*

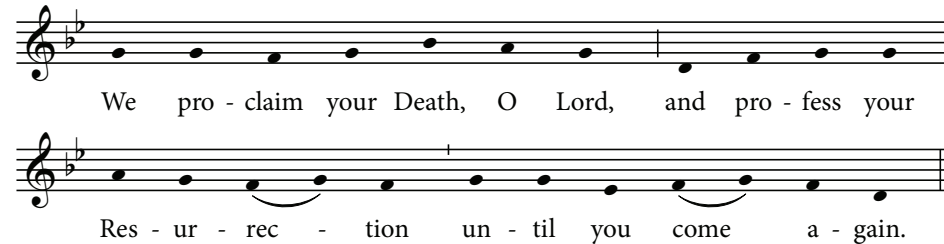
