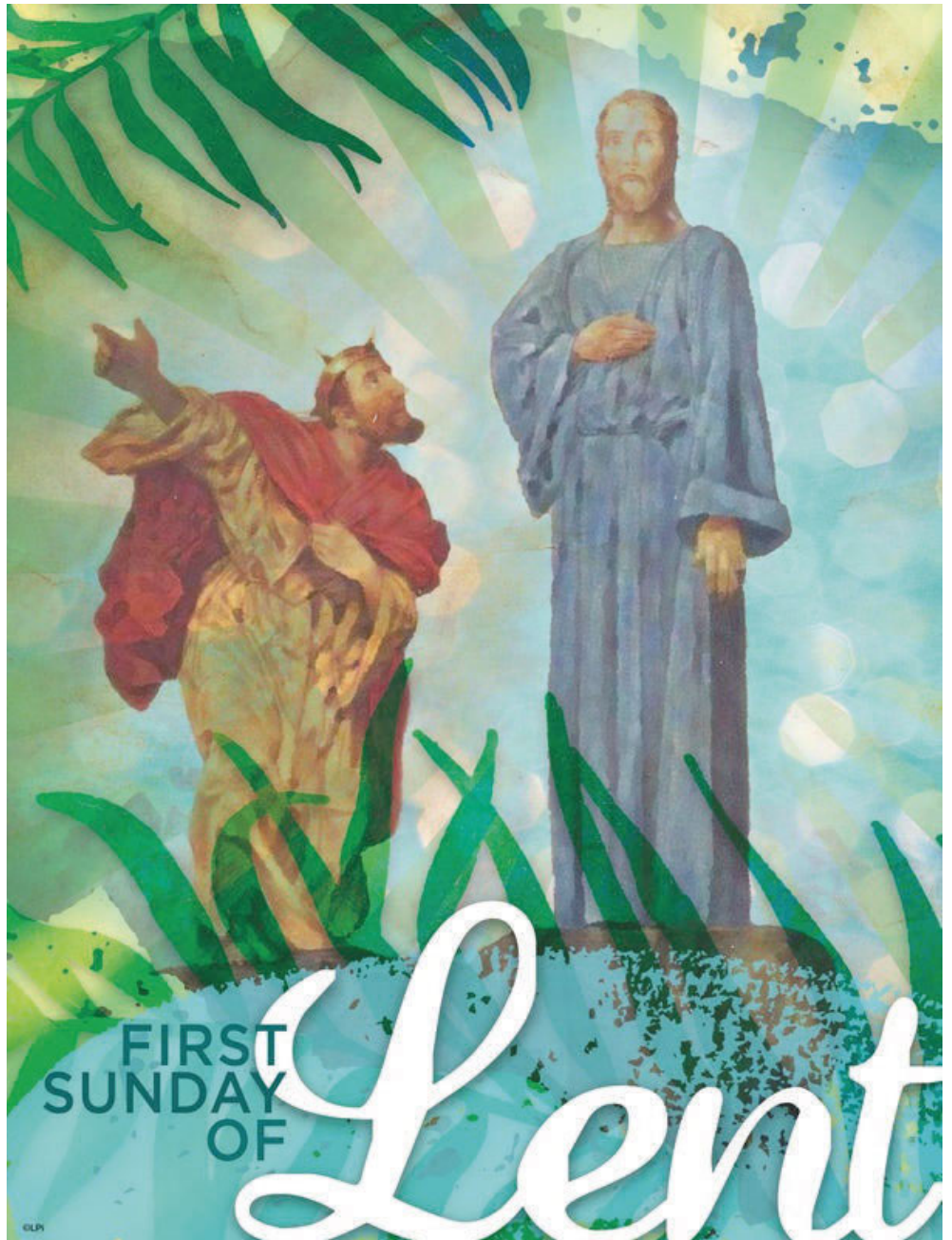

## DIOCESAN RITES OF ELECTION

At the beginning of Lent, which is the proximate preparation for Sacramental Initiation, the "Election" or "Enrollment of Names" is held. Having heard the testimony of godparents and catechists, with the catechumens confirming their intention, the Church discerns their state of preparation and decides whether they may proceed to the Paschal Sacraments. In this step the Church makes her "Election," or the choice and admission of catechumens, who by their dispositions are fit to take part in the next celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation. It is called "Election" because the admission made by the Church is founded on election by God, in whose name the Church acts; it is also called "Enrollment of Names" because the catechumens write their names in the Book of the Elect as a pledge of their faithfulness.

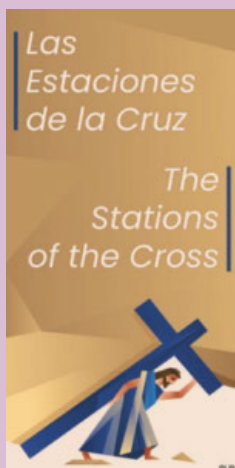

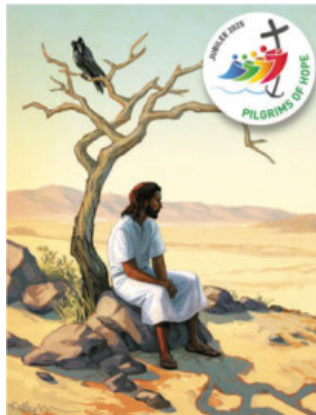

Pilgrims of Hope: Walking with Jesus for 40 Days of Lent

On this first Sunday of Lent, we are invited to walk with Jesus into the desert where he fasts and prays for 40 days. When he is near the end of those 40 days, he is allowed to be tempted by the devil. We may think that he was in a weakened state after his long time of fasting; but he fasted with prayer, and this became a great strength to keep him from taking the voice of the devil seriously. He let prayer be his strength. Have you ever gone without food? What are you like when you are hungry? During Lent, we are called to practice three Lenten traditions:  
**Prayer**—taking more time to be with God in silence, reflection and the Bible.  
**Fasting**—to abstain from eating a favorite food or drink; or to refrain from cussing or spending too much time on the internet.  
**Almsgiving**—give money or other to the poor. Some choose to fast from coffee or dessert, and use the money for the poor.



Our Faith Formation Families have a Lenten Calendar to challenge them to do some small sacrifices during Lent:

- Don't eat between meals.
- Visit Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.
- Share something with someone.
- Pray for those in Purgatory.
- Do a good deed secretly for someone.
- Put someone else before self.

When we make an effort to do small things for love of God and neighbor, we strengthen our will to desire the things of God. What daily sacrifice are you called to make this Lent?

En este primer domingo de Cuaresma, se nos invita a caminar con Jesús por el desierto, donde ayuna y reza durante 40 días. Cuando se acerca el final de esos 40 días, se deja tentar por el diablo. Podemos pensar que se encontraba en un estado debilitado después de su largo tiempo de ayuno; pero ayunó con oración, y esto se convirtió en una gran fortaleza para evitar que tomara en serio la voz del diablo. Dejó que la oración fuera su fuerza. ¿Has estado alguna vez sin comer? ¿Cómo eres cuando tienes hambre? Durante la Cuaresma, estamos llamados a practicar tres tradiciones cuaresmales:

**La oración:** dedicar más tiempo a estar con Dios en silencio, reflexionando y leyendo la Biblia.

**El ayuno:** abstenerse de comer una comida o bebida favorita, de maldecir o de pasar demasiado tiempo en Internet.

**Limosna:** dar dinero u otra cosa a los pobres. Algunos eligen ayunar de café o postre, y usar el dinero para los pobres.

Nuestras Familias de Formación en la Fe tienen un Calendario de Cuaresma para desafiarles a hacer algunos pequeños sacrificios durante la Cuaresma:

- No comer entre comidas
  - Visitar a Jesús Sacramentado
  - Compartir algo con alguien
  - Rezar por los que están en el Purgatorio
  - Hacer una buena acción secreta por alguien.
  - Poner a otro antes que a uno mismo.
- Cuando nos esforzamos por hacer pequeñas cosas por amor a Dios y al prójimo, fortalecemos nuestra voluntad para desear las cosas de Dios. ¿Qué sacrificio diario estás llamado a hacer esta Cuaresma?

## Focus of the Gospel:

Next week in the Gospel of Luke, we will find ourselves up on a mountain with Jesus and his inner circle, Peter, James and John. While praying, Jesus is transfigured before them, his face changing in appearance and his clothing becoming dazzling white. Imagine the scene; one minute they are praying with Jesus like they've done a hundred times before; the next moment he looks otherworldly. They are full of amazement, seeing Jesus glowing in heavenly light with Moses and Elijah standing with him. The disciples are overwhelmed at what they were seeing, only to have their excitement increased with the voice from heaven: "This is my chosen Son; listen to him." They fell silent, quietly looking in awe at their Teacher, Jesus. Jesus has been telling them all along who he was through his teaching and miracles, but they were still not quite getting the truth of who he really was—the Son of God.

## Alone or with your Family / Friends

- ♦ Read the Gospel of Luke 9:28-36 the story of the Transfiguration of Jesus. Place yourself in the story. Are you one of the Disciples? Are you watching from outside, like in a movie?
- ♦ How do you find yourself responding in the story? Are you amazed? Afraid? Still doubtful? What do you hear Jesus saying to you personally?
- ♦ Jesus had been telling them that he must be handed over and to die; the disciples did not want to hear it. Here, God the Father tells the disciples to "Listen to Him". Reflect on a truth you have heard that you do not want to confront or embrace? How can you do better?

## Enfoque del evangelio:

La semana que viene, en el Evangelio de Lucas, nos encontraremos en una montaña con Jesús y su círculo íntimo, Pedro, Santiago y Juan. Mientras oran, Jesús se transfigura ante ellos, su rostro cambia de aspecto y su ropa se vuelve de un blanco deslumbrante. Imagínate la escena: en un momento están rezando con Jesús como lo han hecho cientos de veces antes, y al siguiente parece de otro mundo. Están llenos de asombro, viendo a Jesús resplandeciente en luz celestial con Moisés y Elías de pie junto a él. Los discípulos están sobrecogidos por lo que estaban viendo, sólo para ver aumentada su excitación con la voz del cielo: «Este es mi Hijo elegido; escuchadle». Los discípulos se callan y miran atónitos a su Maestro, Jesús. Jesús les había estado diciendo todo el tiempo quién era a través de sus enseñanzas y milagros, pero ellos todavía no habían captado la verdad de quién era realmente: el Hijo de Dios.

- ♦ Lee el Evangelio de Lucas 9:28-36, el relato de la Transfiguración de Jesús. Sitúate en la historia. ¿Eres uno de los discípulos? ¿Estás observando desde fuera, como en una película?
- ♦ ¿Cómo reaccionas ante la historia? ¿Estás asombrado? ¿Tienes miedo? ¿Sigues dudando? ¿Qué oyes que te dice Jesús personalmente?
- ♦ Jesús les había estado diciendo que debía ser entregado y morir; los discípulos no querían oírlo. Aquí, Dios Padre dice a los discípulos: «Escuchadle». Reflexiona sobre alguna verdad que hayas oído y que no quieras confrontar con nuestro abrazo. ¿Cómo puedes hacerlo mejor?

# Liturgy of the Word

## FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

## MARCH 9, 2025

### READING 1      DT 26:4-10

Moses spoke to the people, saying:

“The priest shall receive the basket from you and shall set it in front of the altar of the LORD, your God. Then you shall declare before the Lord, your God, ‘My father was a wandering Aramean who went down to Egypt with a small household and lived there as an alien. But there he became a nation great, strong, and numerous. When the Egyptians maltreated and oppressed us, imposing hard labor upon us, we cried to the LORD, the God of our fathers, and he heard our cry and saw our affliction, our toil, and our oppression. He brought us out of Egypt with his strong hand and outstretched arm, with terrifying power, with signs and wonders; and bringing us into this country, he gave us this land flowing with milk and honey. Therefore, I have now brought you the firstfruits of the products of the soil which you, O LORD, have given me.’ And having set them before the Lord, your God, you shall bow down in his presence.”

### RESPONSORIAL PSALM PS 91:1-2, 10-11, 12-13, 14-15

**R. Be with me, Lord, when I am in trouble.**

You who dwell in the shelter of the Most High, who abide in the shadow of the Almighty, say to the LORD, “My refuge and fortress, my God in whom I trust.”

### READING 2      ROM 10:8-13

Brothers and sisters:

What does Scripture say? The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart—that is, the word of faith that we preach—, for, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For one believes with the heart and so is justified, and one confesses with the mouth and so is saved. For the Scripture says, No one who believes in him will be put to shame. For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; the same Lord is Lord of all, enriching all who call upon him. For “everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

### VERSE BEFORE THE GOSPEL MT 4:4B

One does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes forth from the mouth of God.

### GOSPEL      LK 4:1-13

Filled with the Holy Spirit, Jesus returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the desert for forty days, to be tempted by the devil. He ate nothing during those days, and when they were over he was hungry. The devil said to him, “If you are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread.” Jesus answered him, “It is written, One does not live on bread alone.” Then he took him up and showed him all the kingdoms of the world in a single instant.
