## NATIONAL Eucharistic Pilgrimage

**WE INVITE YOU TO BE A PILGRIM FOR A DAY!  
Come Join the Eucharistic Pilgrimage  
Wednesday, May 22**

Walk with Bishop Soto and the people of the Diocese of Sacramento along with the National Perpetual Pilgrims at 11:00 am at River Walk Park in West Sacramento across Tower Bridge arriving at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament at noon.

Mass will be celebrated at 12:10 pm with Bishop Soto presiding, followed by Eucharistic Adoration until 4:00 pm. Cathedral parishioners are encouraged to participate while celebrating the Eucharist as the source and summit of our faith. Through this gift, we encounter Jesus Christ.

As background information, this Pilgrimage is part of the National Eucharistic Revival that began in June 2022. On Pentecost weekend, the Perpetual Pilgrims will set out on different processions from the four corners of the United States arriving in Indianapolis for the National Eucharistic Congress, July 17-21.

Covering over 2,200 miles, the St. Junipero Serra Route (west) is the longest and most challenging of the four routes. On May 21, the Serra Route begins in the Archdiocese of San Francisco and arrives in the Sacramento Diocese starting in Vallejo traveling the Delta waterways. On May 22, the Pilgrims travel through Sacramento to the Cathedral. The next day, May 23, they continue their journey through the eastern part of the Diocese to South Lake Tahoe. From there, the Pilgrims will process across Lake Tahoe to Incline Village, Nevada ultimately traveling through 18 dioceses across 11 states before arriving in Indianapolis for the National Eucharistic Congress on July 17.

Camine con el Obispo Soto y la gente de la Diócesis de Sacramento junto con los Peregrinos Perpetuos Nacionales a las **11:00 am en River Walk Park** en West Sacramento a través del Tower Bridge y llegue a la Catedral del Santísimo Sacramento al mediodía.

La Misa se celebrará a las 12:10 pm presidida por el Obispo Soto, seguida de la Adoración Eucarística hasta las 4:00 pm. Se anima a los feligreses de la catedral a participar mientras celebran la Eucaristía como fuente y cumbre de nuestra fe. A través de este regalo, encontramos a Jesucristo.

Como información general, esta Peregrinación es parte del Avivamiento Eucarístico Nacional que comenzó en junio de 2022. El fin de semana de Pentecostés, los Peregrinos Perpetuos emprenderán diferentes procesiones desde los cuatro rincones de los Estados Unidos y llegarán a Indianápolis para el Congreso Eucarístico Nacional, en julio. 17-21.

La ruta de San Junípero Serra (oeste), que cubre más de 2200 millas, es la más larga y desafiante de las cuatro rutas. El 21 de mayo la Ruta Serra inicia en la Arquidiócesis de San Francisco y llega a la Diócesis de Sacramento iniciando en Vallejo recorriendo las vías fluviales del Delta. El 22 de mayo los Peregrinos viajan por Sacramento hasta la Catedral. Al día siguiente, 23 de mayo, continúan su viaje por la parte este de la Diócesis hasta South Lake Tahoe. Desde allí, los peregrinos cruzarán el lago Tahoe hasta Incline Village, Nevada, y finalmente viajarán a través de 18 diócesis en 11 estados antes de llegar a Indianápolis para el Congreso Eucarístico Nacional el 17 de julio.

## Preparation for Sunday Mass Sunday, 5 MAY 24

### Prepare: 6th Sunday of Easter

Acts 10:25-26, 34-35, 44-48

### Focus of the Gospel:

The readings from 1st John and the Gospel of John, combined, mention 'love' 17 times. LOVE—LOVE—LOVE. The message rings loud and clear, right? Or does it? What does 'love' mean? I can love my coffee and I know that isn't the same thing as loving a person. Pope Benedict XVI wrote about this problem in the encyclical Deus Caritas Est. He recognized we use love in three basic categories: EROS, a love of passion (where our senses are gratified and pleased); PHILIA, a brotherly love or friendship, and AGAPE, a self-emptying love. In the New Testament, eros isn't found a single time; philia is used when speaking about relationship between people, in friendship; and then agape is used to point to a higher love—one that is willing to even love ones enemies. As followers of Jesus, we are called to live this self-giving love, and let Jesus be made known through our loving of one another as He loved us.

### Enfoque del evangelio:

Las lecturas de 1ª Juan y del Evangelio de Juan, combinadas, mencionan el “amor” 17 veces. AMOR-AMOR-AMOR. El mensaje suena alto y claro, ¿verdad? ¿O no? ¿Qué significa “amor”? Puedo amar mi café y sé que no es lo mismo que amar a una persona. El Papa Benedicto XVI escribió sobre este problema en la encíclica Deus Caritas Est. Reconoció que utilizamos el amor en tres categorías básicas: EROS, un amor de pasión (donde nuestros sentidos son gratificados y complacidos); FILIA, un amor fraternal o amistad, y AGAPE, un amor de auto-vaciamiento. En el Nuevo Testamento, eros no se encuentra ni una sola vez; philia se usa cuando se habla de la relación entre personas, en la amistad; y luego ágape se usa para señalar un amor más elevado -uno que está dispuesto incluso a amar a los enemigos. Como seguidores de Jesús, estamos llamados a vivir este amor que se entrega y a dar a conocer a Jesús amándonos los unos a los otros como Él nos amó.

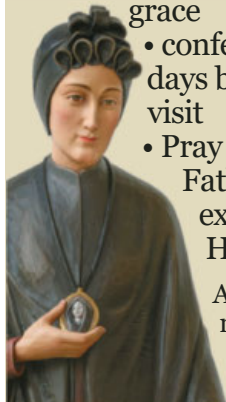

A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥122 (Matt 瑪11:28-30) Fr. Abraham Chiu 趙必成神父

How do we forgive those who hurt us, either deeply or slightly? If you will, you can; if you refuse, you cannot. People will feel lightly while they forgive others and themselves; on the contrary, heavy while they do no. Better said, with love, everything is easy as well as without love, everything is heavy. Love, thus, is the strongest power, not any laws.

Jesus' yoke is easy and his burden light. It is mainly because they are carried by love. As a matter of fact, they are not only physically easy and light but spiritually. Those who are willing to forgive have to work together with God who is the source of forgiving love. That is the reason for the easy yoke and the light burden. Nevertheless, the Pharisees built a fence around the Law with their own incorrect exposition of its meaning so that no one can enter into the center spirit of the Law. However, Jesus was faithful to the heart of the Law, i.e. love.

Jesus said, "Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me." The "yoke" (zygon) literally means a heavy burden but here; metaphorically, the term is so transferred to the love command of Jesus as to contrast the burden with the Pharisees. Jesus called his disciples to righteousness in obedience to the Law of love. This love promises the rest and peace that anticipate eschatological blessing.

Christian discipleship requires nothing less than life commitment. While Christians are carrying their heavy crosses of life, in fact, it is Jesus who carries the yoke and burden together with them. In these situations, "his commandments are not burdensome" (1 John 5:3) because we carry with love and Jesus accompanies us in our hard times.

Jesus wants to share with us his intimacy with God our Father by inviting us to join his life, especially his death and resurrection. When we commit our lives into Jesus', we share his easy yoke and light burden because, and only because, Jesus had taken up our difficult yoke and heavy burden by committing his life to ours, even unto death.

如何寬恕那些傷害我們的人？無論嚴重或輕微。願意，就行；拒絕，就不能。人心在寬恕他人或自己時，會感到輕鬆；相反，如果抗拒寬恕，心如堵塞大石，沉重。更好說，有愛，一切都很容易，缺愛，所有人事物都沉重。因此，愛是最強力量，而非任何規矩。

耶穌的軛是柔和的，擔子是輕鬆的；主因是以愛肩負；事實上，不只是身體上的柔和及輕鬆，而是精神上。那些願意寬恕的人必須與天主合作，因祂是寬恕之愛的泉源；這就是軛柔和以及擔子輕鬆原因。然而，法利塞人用他們自己對法律的錯誤解釋，在法律周圍築起圍牆，讓人不能進入核心，而耶穌則忠於法律精神，是愛。

耶穌說：“你們背起我的軛，跟我學吧！”“軛” (zygon) 字面意思是沉重負擔，但這裡比喻耶穌愛的命令，與法利塞人的重擔形成對比。耶穌召叫門徒遵守愛的法律而成義，這愛引導人們進入安息，是邁向末世的祝福。

基督徒，無非一生奉獻自己生命給主；當他們背負生命沉重十字架時，事實上，是耶穌與他們一起背負這軛和擔子；在這情況下，“他的誡命並不沉重” (若壹5:3)，因為懷著愛去背負；與此同時，耶穌在我們困難時，一直陪伴。

耶穌希望我們分享他的生命，特別是死亡復活，從而與我們分享他與天父之間的親密關係。當我們將生命交託耶穌，就分擔他柔和的軛和輕鬆擔子，因為，也只是因為，耶穌將生命委身給我們，甚至死在十字架上，好能背負我們困難的軛和沉重擔子。
